Which is the real aggressor and threat to world peace?	
USA	North Korea
Has this nation conducted illegal wars and military operations against its own democratic laws?	
Yes; many times. E.g. Libya, Syria, Somalia, Yemen, Pakistan.	No; not ever.
Has this nation conducted illegal wars and military operations against international law?	
Yes; many times. E.g. Kosovo, Iraq, Afghanistan, Libya, Somalia – they were not taken in self-defence or approved by the UN Security Council – thus illegal by international treaty definition.	No; not ever.
Has this nation invaded and annexed other nations for greed?	
Yes; many times. E.g. Hawaii (1898), Puerto Rico (1898), Texas (1836), The Philippines (1901), Native American lands (19thc.) etc.	No; not ever.
Has this nation invaded sovereign nations to secure regime change?	
Yes; many times. E.g. Vietnam (1960-75), former Yugoslavia (1992-94), Afghanistan (2003-now), Iraq (2003-2011), Korea (1894-6 and 1950-53), Panama (1989-90), etc.	No; not ever.
Has this nation organised, funded and supported military coups and rebellions in foreign nations?	
Yes; dozens of times. E.g. Syria (2011-), Ukraine (2014-), Libya (2011-), Indonesia (1998), Argentina (1890), Chile (1891), Nicaragua (1894), China (1894-5), Guatemala (1954 and 1966-7), El Salvador (1981-92), Nicaragua (1981-90) etc. Overall, America has illegally intervened in about 100 nations.	No; not ever.
Has this nation illegally bombed other sovereign nations?	
Yes; many times. E.g. Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Iraq, Syria, Libya, Somalia, Yemen, Afghanistan, Yugoslavia etc.	No; not ever.
Has this nation illegally carpet bombed cities causing hundreds of thousands of deaths?	
Yes; it has. One example alone is the bombing of Pyongyang in the Korean War. America dropped more bombs on this one city than it dropped in the entire WWII Pacific theatre. Overall the US killed 4 million Koreans.	No; it has not.
Has this nation deployed illegal drone missile strikes on sovereign nations?	
Yes; many times. E.g. Yemen, Pakistan, Afghanistan etc.	No; not ever.

Has this nation ever used nuclear weapons on another nation?	
Yes; twice. Nagasaki and Hiroshima in Japan in 1945.	No; not ever.
Has this nation used illegal or disputed weapons?	
Yes; many times. E.g. cluster bombs and various types of mines that kill children for years after a conflict.	No; not ever.
Has this nation used chemical weapons?	
Yes; many times. E.g. depleted uranium shells (e.g. Iraq); CS gas shells on rockets, Tear Gas shells on rockets (both illegal in warfare; Korea, Iraq, Syria). Napalm (Korea, Vietnam, Cambodia).	No; not ever.
Has this nation ever used biological weapons?	
Yes; many times. E.g. Agent Orange in Vietnam and Cambodia ('Operation Ranch Hand'). As well as killing plant life and trees, it caused major suffering for 4 million people (e.g. cancer) and killed animals.	No; not ever.
Has this nation been responsible for the deaths of millions of people?	
Yes. E.g. 4m in Korea, 1.5m in Iraq; 400k in Syria; 80k in Hiroshima; up to 80k in Nagasaki; hundreds of thousands in Indonesia; untold thousands of Native American Indians; thousands in Libya, etc.	No; not ever.
Has this nation manipulated the media to lie about its misdeeds?	
Yes, constantly since it controls the western media.	No, it has no power to influence foreign media.
Has this nation set up multiple foreign military bases?	
Yes; many. In fact 800 military bases in over 70 countries. E.g. It has bases in Britain, Germany, Italy, Spain, Japan, the Middle East, Turkey, Syria, Iraq, Guam, Singapore, Afghanistan, Eastern Europe, Australia, South Korea and many more places.	No; none at all.
Does this nation patrol the oceans with naval strike forces threatening other nations?	
Yes; it does. It has carriers and strike groups in the South China Sea, the Yellow Sea, the Mediterranean, the Western and Eastern Pacific and elsewhere.	No; it does not.
Has this nation used geo-engineering as a military strategy?	
Yes; it has. E.g. 'Operation Popeye' in Vietnam when it produced torrential rains over the Ho-Chi-Minh trail.	No; it has not.
