History of Palestine

Introduction

In order to understand the geo-politics of the current situation in Israel it is vital to know the history of that troubled land.

Since there are such fervent vested interests involved in this matter, a factual history is critical to know the background to current events. This history must be vigorous, factual and without bias. This is what I seek to do here.

It will become clear that I condemn one side in this conflict. This is a conclusion driven by facts and history, not prejudice.

Disclaimer

To make matters clear: I do not condone violence of any kind. I am opposed to war, military action to solve political problems and terrorism from all sides. I condemn brutality from any quarter.

What is Palestine?

The word

'Palestine' is from the Greek *Palaistinē* (used in early Christian writing) and from the Latin (*Syria*) *Palaestina*, the name of the Roman province, which derives from *Philistia* - 'land of the Philistines'. In short, it is the Roman name for the territory of the Philistines.

Philistines

'Philistia' (Ps 60:8, 87:4, 108:9) is claimed to mean 'the land of wanderers' or 'of strangers'. The Philistines were a tribe allied to the Phoenicians.

Philistine territory principally occupied the eastern coast of the Mediterranean Sea; a strip of coastal land west of ancient Israel. However, they spread over the whole district of the Lebanon, the valley of the Jordan, Crete and other Mediterranean islands. In the time of Abraham they inhabited the south-west of Judea, Abimelech of Gerar being their king (Gen 21:32, 34, 26:1). However, they are not named among the Canaanite tribes mentioned in the Pentateuch. They were not a Semitic race but after they settled in Canaan they adopted the Semitic language of the country.

Their origins appear to be from Crete. They are spoken of by Amos (Amos 9:7) and Jeremiah (Jer 47:4) as from Caphtor, i.e., probably Crete, but some think from the Delta of Egypt.

In the Biblical history from Exodus to Samuel they are shown as inhabiting the tract which lay between Judaea and Egypt (Exod 13:17, 15:14-15; Josh 13:3; 1 Sam 4:1). They were a warlike tribe that was a constant enemy of Israel. They were not fully subdued until the reign of Hezekiah (2 Kg 18:8). However they still occupied their territory and continually expressed hatred for Israel (Ezek 25:15-17) until finally conquered by the Romans.

The Philistines are called Pulsata or Pulista on the Egyptian monuments; the land of the Philistines (Philistia) being termed Palastu and Pilista in the Assyrian inscriptions. They occupied the five cities of Gaza, Ashkelon, Ashdod, Ekron, and Gath, in the south-western corner of Canaan, which belonged to Egypt up to the closing days of the Nineteenth Dynasty. The occupation took place during the reign of Rameses III. of the Twentieth Dynasty. The Philistines had formed part of the great naval confederacy which attacked Egypt, but were eventually repulsed by that Pharaoh, who, however, could not dislodge them from their settlements in Palestine. As they did not enter Palestine till the time of the Exodus, the use of the name Philistines in (Ge 26:1) must be proleptic. Indeed the country was properly Gerar, as in ch. 20. They are called Allophyli, "foreigners," in the Septuagint, and in the Books of Samuel they are spoken of as uncircumcised. ... Many scholars identify the Philistines with the Pelethites of (2Sa 8:18).

Roman period

From Philistia the name of the land of the Philistines came to be extended to the whole of Palestine. By the Roman period, 'Palestine' came to mean what Victorians called 'The Holy Land' and what is today called Eretz (State of) Israel.

What is Canaan?

This equates to the land later described by the Romans as Palestine.

The name was originally used by the Phoenicians to denote the maritime plain on which Sidon was built. Later, in the time of Moses and Joshua, it described the whole country west of the Jordan (Deut 11:30). Occasionally, the LXX translates 'land of Canaan' into 'land of the Phoenicians' e.g. Josh 5:12.

The name signifies 'lowlands' as opposed to Gilead on the east of Jordan, which was mountainous. The boundaries of Canaan are explained in several Scriptures (e.g. Gen 10:19, 17:8; Num 13:29, 34:8).

Summary of history

- Canaanite tribes, Hittites and later Phoenicians, ruled over Palestine from after the flood (c. 2245 BC) to the time of Joshua (1405 BC). Philistines entered the land after the Exodus.
- After the conquest of Canaan by Israel, the land was chiefly in the hands of Israelites divided into 12 tribes. However, some pockets of Canaanite tribes continued to exist.
- After the division of the Israelite monarchy, Palestine chiefly comprised the kingdoms of Israel (Northern Kingdom) and Judah.
- Sovereignty over the whole of Palestine by Israelite authority only lasted from the time of Joshua (c. 1405 BC or 1250 BC)¹ to the Assyrian invasion and subsequent exile of Samaria (Northern Kingdom, Israel) in 721 BC. This means that Hebrews only had sovereignty over all Palestine for 684 years (longer for Judah, 819 years until the Babylonian deportations). Even so, in these periods some empires had political control at various times.

However, the archaeology is ambiguous so conservative Biblical scholars accept the 1446 BC date.

- The land was controlled at various times by the Egyptian, Assyrian, Babylonian, Persian, and Roman empires who subjugated Israel.
- It was conquered by the Arabs in 634 AD and ruled over by various caliphates.
- It remained in Muslim hands, except for a brief period during the Crusades (1098–1197).
- It was part of the Ottoman Empire from 1516 to 1918.
- Palestine was thus in Muslim hands for nearly 1,400 years.
- The name Palestine was used as the official political title for the land west of the Jordan mandated to Britain in 1920.
- In 1948 the state of Israel was established in what was traditionally Palestine.
- The name continued to be used for Palestinian Arabs.
- In 1993 an agreement was signed between Israel and the Palestine Liberation Organisation (PLO) giving some autonomy to the Gaza Strip and the West Bank and setting up the Palestine National Authority and a police force.

Ancient history

Pre-deluvian

This is very hard to assess since all we have is texts from Genesis up to chapter 6 describing tribes and clans with few background details.

Post-deluvian

Palestine was chiefly occupied by the Canaanites after the flood but also the Phoenicians in the north coastal plain and some Semites living on the east of the isthmus of Suez. They were nomadic and pastoral tribes. The Phoenicians were merchants and traders. Syria was occupied by the powerful Hittites from the Euphrates to Damascus, north of Galilee.

Canaanites migrated west after the flood settling first in the Persian Gulf, then the mountains of Lebanon and finally reaching the Mediterranean coast.

Canaan was the fourth son of Ham (Gen 10:6). His descendants were under God's curse due to the iniquity of Ham (Gen 9:22-27). His eldest son, Zidon, was the father of the Sidonians and Phoenicians. Canaan had eleven sons, who were the founders of as many tribes (Gen 10:15-18). These were: Sidonians, Heth (Hittites), Jebusites, Amorites, Girgashites, Hivites, Arkites, Sinites, Arvadites, Zemarites, and the Hama-ites.

During the 840 years of occupation before being conquered by Joshua there were various changes so that the tribes are frequently numbered as six or seven. Six different tribes are mentioned in Exod 3:8, 17, 23:23, 33:2, 34:11. In Exod 13:5 the Perizzites are omitted. The Girgashites are mentioned in addition to the foregoing in Deut 7:1; Josh 3:10.

The Canaanites were distinguished from the Amalekites in the south; the Hittites, Jebusites and Amorites in the mountains, and the Anakim, and the Rephaim (giants). They were lowlanders (Num 13:29) occupying the great plains and valleys, the richest and most important parts of Palestine from the sea to the Jordan.

The most commercially important cities were Tyre and Sidon and Canaanites came to represent trading (Job 41:6; Prov 31:24).

Canaan came under the sovereignty of the New Kingdom of Egypt during 1550-1400 BC.

Israel was commanded to utterly destroy the Canaanites as judgment for their great sins but this was never fully carried out. Even after the return from exile survivors of five Canaanite tribes were still present in the land.

In the Tell-el-Amarna tablets Canaan is found under the forms of Kinakhna and Kinakhkhi. Under the name of Kanana the Canaanites appear on Egyptian monuments, wearing a coat of mail and helmet, and distinguished by the use of spear and javelin and the battle-axe. They were called Phoenicians by the Greeks and Poeni by the Romans. By race the Canaanites were Semitic. They were famous as merchants and seamen, as well as for their artistic skill.

Israel

Joshua and the Judges

Israel conquered Canaan under the leadership of Joshua. However, after his death the land came under the power of various kings in the period of the Judges. There would be an Israelite deliverance for a generation under a leader such as Gideon, Othniel or Samson but then another invasion by a foreign king.

So even in this period Israel did not have continual sovereignty over Palestine.

The united monarchy

This period saw the greatest period of full sovereignty.

It began with victories over the Philistines by Saul but his failures soon led to setbacks under God's judgment.

On the death of Saul, David became king and fulfilled the promises of a kingdom from the Euphrates to the Nile. This victory was further enjoyed by Solomon who presided over peace and a period of great building, such as the temple.

On Solomon's death there was a rebellion leading to the division of the monarchy. The north (Israel) was the Northern Kingdom while Judah was the Southern Kingdom.

Assvria

The sins and idolatry of Israel led to God's judgment and this resulted in an Assyrian invasion which conquered Israel in 721 BC and carried off hundreds of thousands of captives spread within the Assyrian Empire. Foreign people were imported into the Northern Kingdom which was more often called Samaria by this time. The Hebrews from Judah hated this admixture of peoples.

Babylonia

Judah continued for a while but her idolatry excelled that of Israel, resulting in God's judgment. Babylon invaded Judah and conquered it in 586 BC. There were three sets of deportation whereby Jews were carried off into Babylonia for 70 years.

The return under the Medo-Persian Empire (Achaemenid)

When the Achaemenids conquered Babylon, Cyrus the Great allowed the Jews to return to Palestine to rebuild the temple. This was the final period of Hebrew titular sovereignty over the land, but under the overall domination of the Medo-Persian Empire.

Biblical silence

The 400 year period after the return of the exiles to the birth of Jesus Christ is a period of silence in Biblical history. The Bible says nothing about it.

I have written about this complicated history in a separate paper.

Greece

Alexander the Great subsequently conquered the Persian Empire by defeating Darius III. This established a new world empire of significant importance.

After the death of Alexander, the empire was divided amongst his generals.² Palestine was ruled by the Seleucids. This was a period of suffering for the Jews in Palestine, especially under Antiochus IV (Epiphanes; c.215-163 BC) who tried to Hellenise Judaea.

The Maccabees (Hasmonaeans)

There was a successful revolt against the Seleucid rule of Antiochus Epiphanes led by the Maccabees. This was prompted by the idolatrous edicts of Antiochus in 167 BC. In 164 the edicts were rescinded and the temple cleansed (celebrated by Hanukkah). After this the empire was politically unstable and the Romans aided the Jewish rebels to further destabilise the Seleucids.

Around 140 Judaea became de facto independent. Judah began conquering its neighbours and Edom (Idumea) became Jewish. By 100 Judaea included all of Palestine up to Galilee. This is the period of Hasmonaean rule.

Rome

Rome decided to annex the land into the Roman Empire making Judah a client kingdom in 63 BC. We are introduced to Roman rule in the Bible at the time of the birth of Jesus.

Originally Rome named the land Judaea but historians (e.g. Philo, Josephus, Pliny) referred to it as Syria Palestina (the southern portion of the province of Syria). In the early 2nd century AD Syria Palaestina became the official Roman name for the land to isolate Jews after the Bar Kokhba revolt. The area was also much larger than Judaea.

Rome, and later the Byzantine (Eastern Roman) Empire, thus held Palestine from 63 BC to the invasion by Muslims in 640 AD, a period of 703 years. The Arabic word *Filastin* was used for the area since the 7th century.

The fall of Jerusalem

The Jews lived in peace under Roman rule because there was religious toleration. However, there was a growing Zealot rebellion which became active in the 60s provoking a serious Roman response under Titus and Vespasian.

After a terrible siege, that Jesus prophesied, Titus conquered Jerusalem in 70 AD enacting a terrible retribution. Judah was denuded of trees to make crosses for crucifixions, which lined the main roads. Those that were not killed were made captives and dispersed throughout the empire (the Diaspora).

This was the end of Judaism prophesied by God. The temple was destroyed so that Judaism could never be conducted according to the Mosaic Law (Torah). Jerusalem was raised to the ground. The people were removed.

In this vacuum other people moved in, chiefly Idumaeans³ from across the Jordan. These gradually became the Sephardim branch of world Jewry after they migrated to Spain at a later date.⁴

The fall of Rome in the West; Byzantine control

After the fall of Rome in 476 AD the eastern empire was ruled by Constantinople (Byzantine Empire). This continued until defeat by the Muslim Arabs. Constantinople was captured by the Ottoman Turks in 1453.

Muslim rule

Multiple caliphates dominated Palestine for centuries. This was except for 100 years when the land was occupied and ruled by the Crusaders. These caliphates include:

- Abu Bakr was the first caliph, a pope-king, [reigned: 632-634]. 634: Gaza sacked.
- The second caliph Umar [reigned: 634-644]. 640: Jerusalem sacked, Palestine controlled.
- The third Caliph Uthman [reigned: 644-656].
- Ali [reigned: 656-661].
- The Umayyad dynasty of caliphs [661-750].
- The Abbasid dynasty [750-1258].
- Period of Mongol and Tartar empires.
- The Ottomans [1534-1918].

Conclusion

Ancient history shows that no one group has any major claim over the land of Palestine (except for Muslims).

Israel held sovereignty over the whole land for less than a millennium while the Canaanites held it for longer, but they are extinct. Hebrews had sovereignty over all Palestine for 684 years and over Judah 819 years. However, even while holding titular sovereignty over Palestine, Israel was actually under the dominance of several world powers for many years during that time. Complete sovereign control over all Palestine only occurred under the kingdoms of David and Solomon. Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, Persia and Greece controlled the land for centuries. Romans controlled Palestine for several hundred years. The Byzantine Empire controlled the land for only 164 years. Muslims occupied the land for 1389 years.

In terms of historic sovereign control, the Jewish claim for Palestine is very weak.

The divine termination of Jewish sovereignty over Palestine

Summary

Jews claim that God gave Palestine to Jews alone. This was once true but God subsequently removed that grant due to the sins of the Jews. Just as God gave the land to the Canaanites, but later removed them from the land due to sinfulness, so God also denied the land to Jews for their rebellion.

History

The claim of Jews is that Palestine is the promised land to the Jews by God. This was certainly true after the Exodus and the subsequent conquest of Canaan by Joshua. Israel occupied the land of Canaan as the promised land.

However, the Jews continually provoked God's anger by their constant idolatry and rebellion. God repeatedly called them a 'stiff-necked rebellious' people. Two exiles were the result of God's anger and the ten tribes of the Northern Kingdom virtually disappeared, being assimilated in the Assyrian Empire in 721 BC. The Northern Kingdom became occupied by a mixed people called the Samaritans, hated by Jews. The Southern Kingdom (Judah) was captured by the Babylonians in 586 BC with the population deported in three waves.

Some Jews (about 300,000) returned from Babylon under the Edict of Cyrus the Great to re-establish Jerusalem and rebuild the temple. The people survived through the Seleucid sovereignty and the successful Maccabean revolt but then ended up under Roman control.

During the Roman occupation of Palestine Jesus the Messiah was born and ministered. Judaism, dominated by factional rivalry and superficial religion, was targeted by Jesus. His attacks chiefly were against the legalistic Pharisees, but also the agnostic Sadducees and the corrupt scribes and priests. Consequently the religious leaders hated him and thus rejected their own Messiah. After collusion by the priests and Pharisees, the Sanhedrin condemned Jesus to death. By Roman law they had to get the governor Pontius Pilate to approve of the execution, which he eventually consented to under duress. Jesus was then crucified by Jewish orders, implemented by the Roman soldiers, who all chanted that the guilt be upon them and their children: 'And all the people answered and said, "His blood be on us and on our children" (Matt 27:25).

Thus the Jews committed the most heinous sin – to crucify their own Messiah. For this rejection of God (a final rejection after centuries of rejecting God) the judgment on the Jews was severe.

Jesus prophesied about this and stated categorically:

- That the Jewish people would be **rejected** for rejecting the Messiah. 'Let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole. "This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone". (Acts 4:10-11). 'Therefore, to you who believe, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone, and a stone of stumbling and a rock of offence." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed'. (1 Pt 2:7-8).
- That they would be **crushed** into powder. 'Whoever falls on this stone will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder. Now when the chief priests and Pharisees heard His parables, they perceived that He was speaking of them.' (Matt 21:44-45).
- That the kingdom would be **removed** from them and given to the Gentiles. 'The kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it.' (Matt 21:43).
- The nation would be left **desolate**. 'O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! See! Your house is left to you desolate.' (Matt 23:37-38).

This is the divine judgment: the Jews are no longer the chosen people, the people of God, they no longer have the kingdom and are no longer entitled to occupy Palestine. In fact they become the enemies of the Gospel (Rm 11:28) and despised by all people (1 Thess 2:15).

The modern Jewish claim that God gave them Palestine

The majority of Jews today are Ashkenazi. These are the descendants of Khazarians, a medieval state in the Ukraine, Azerbaijan, southern Russia area. This was a Turkic / Mongol people who occupied a large part of southern Russia from the 6th to the 11th centuries and who converted to Judaism in the 8th century.

After being defeated by the Varangian Russians they were dispersed throughout Europe, becoming the Ashkenazi Jews. These Jews never lived in Palestine and have no claim to it.⁵

Sephardim Jews (the biggest minority group) descended from the Idumaeans that moved into Judaea after the Fall of Jerusalem in 70 AD. They emanate from the Edomites that were Semitic (from Esau) but were cursed by God. They did occupy Palestine historically but had no part in the promise of God to Israelites. Most of these relocated to Spain over

time, hence 'Spanish (Sephardi) Jews' to join historic Jews that had migrated to Spain since the first century.

Therefore the two main groups of modern Jews have no divine claim to Palestine whatsoever.

When Israeli Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu stated, 'God gave this land to our Israelite forefathers', he was lying. Jewish forefathers were Khazars in Russia. Netanyahu's father was a Khazar Jew born in Poland. He has no connection to OT Israelites whatsoever.

Conclusion

The religious claim of Jews over Palestine is zero.

Modern history

Muslim rule (1516 to 1917)

The Ottoman Empire continued to dominate Palestine from 1516 to 1917 into the 20th century. This changed after WWI when Turkish and German forces were defeated by the British at Megiddo.

Zionism

Background

In 1897 Theodore Herzl started this movement advocating the return of Jews to Palestine. It is essentially a secular movement; its political character is seen in Herzl's *Der Judenstaat* (1896). However, it has adopted certain religious tenets favourable to its position. These include:

- Jews are the chosen people of God.
- Jews will be reunited from the Diaspora.
- Jews will return to their original homeland.
- That homeland, Palestine, belongs to Jews alone.

The basis of Zionist claim to Palestine is three errors:

- It has a divine right to the land because Jews are God's people promised it. See earlier for a refutation of this.
- A historical right. I.e. Jews have always owned this land but have been absent from it since 70 AD. Many nations held Palestine for longer. Muslims have the longest standing claim. See earlier for details.
- It has a compelling reason. I.e. the Holocaust requires it. Sometimes this is enhanced by referral to centuries of claimed Jewish persecution. What about the bigger holocausts such as: Germans, Russians, and Chinese? Suffering in one country does not give you the right to steal someone else's country.

The issue of the Balfour Declaration in 1917 and the grant of a mandate for Palestine to Britain gave impetus to the movement.

Chaim Weizmann, leader of the World Zionist Organisation, and the Jewish Agency facilitated Jewish immigration to Palestine by investment, buying land and sponsoring communities.

As Herzl had proposed as a strategic move 50 years before, the suffering of Jews in WWII strengthened the claim to get a homeland. Thus the Holocaust narrative (which was insignificant immediately after the war) was ramped up in propaganda from Jewish owned newspapers. Zionist activities in USA were influential in winning the support of Congress and the Presidency in 1946–48 for the creation of the state of Israel.

Today the World Zionist Congress, an independent body, exists to support Jewish emigration to Israel.

The problem: the Holocaust does not justify ethnic cleansing

Modern Jews affirm that the terrible suffering of Jews in the Holocaust (the scope of which is open to many questions) is sufficient reason to grant Jews the right to a Palestinian homeland. Golda Meir (Israel PM 1969-74) stated this openly.

But this raises many questions:

- Palestine was already occupied by people that have lived there for virtually 2,000 years.
 Many of those people are Semitic and have claims to lineage from Abraham but are not
 Jews (most of these are Christians). Muslim Palestinians have been there over 1000
 vears.
- Immigration of tens of thousands of Jews would require removing tens of thousands of indigenous Palestinians. This is illegal.
- The Balfour declaration was meaningless in international law. Britain had no right to promise a foreign people the land of a different foreign people that it had no sovereignty over.
- The suffering of Jews in the war gave it no legal right to a foreign territory.
- The Jews were not alone in suffering in WWII. Many groups also suffered; many suffered far more. 25 million Russians died. 15 million Germans died. Millions of innocent German civilians (mostly women) died, or were tortured and raped at the end of the war as the Russians advanced from the east. 1.5 million Germans died in open air prison camps after the war ended. 6 million Germans were taken to Russia after the war and vanished; presumed murdered or enslaved. Large numbers of Poles died. There was Nazi persecution of Gypsies, the disabled, homosexuals and other minorities. The number of dead Jews has been formally reduced (but ignored by the media) instead of 4 million dying in Auschwitz, it is now admitted that there was about 1.5 million (even this is questioned). So the 6 million Holocaust figure is now officially 3.5 million and still being questioned.

Zionism demands majority Jewish rule

After the existence of Israel within Palestinian territory, the principles of Zionism demanded that Jews had a majority position in the land to enable it to be a Jewish state: 'the creation of a Jewish majority ... was the fundamental aim of Zionism'.⁶ This meant the removal of the majority Arabs. This is the basis of Israeli-Palestinian tension and the source of violent strategies. Thus Berl Katznelson affirmed that a Jewish state meant forcing the will of the Jews on the Arabs.⁷ At the beginning, this meant that Arabs were to live under sufferance of Jewish authority; gradually this developed into hawkish plans to eradicate all Palestinians in Israel, best exemplified by Netanyahu.

Zionists justify their historical right to impose a Jewish state through the 'Right of Return'; a unique claim of Jews to that land. I have demonstrated that this is a lie. Nevertheless, the chief Zionist principle is, 'to restore full or partial sovereignty over Palestine to the Jewish people'.8

Population transfer

The Zionist canard that the Palestinian Arabs' real homelands are other Muslim nations such as Iraq or Syria, to which they could easily migrate to, is utter sophistry. 1) Many of the Palestinians are not Muslim but are Christian, Druze, atheists or others. They have no identification with these Islamic lands but identify with Palestine, as they have for

centuries. 2) The immigration of millions of Palestinians to these nations would destabilise the society, social infrastructure and political stability; to say nothing of where would they all be housed. 3) No one has sought the consent of the governments or people of these territories to accept this plan. Would you accept the sudden immigration of over 3 million foreign people in one move?

Zionism not universally accepted by Jews

Zionism is not accepted by all Jews, or even all Israeli Jews. Liberal Jews do not accept it. Various branches of Orthodox Judaism reject it, such as Torah Jews. Many rabbis formally denounce Zionism as evil and declare that the state of Israel is wrong and contrary to the Torah. Zionism is only accepted by political Jews (i.e. those in power) and Talmudic Jews. Many modern atheistic Jews in Israel oppose Zionism for causing destabilisation of the area and are calling for Netanyahu to step down.

Jews in Palestine before 1948

In general, Jews had historically lived peacefully amongst the Palestinian people that tolerated various religions, chiefly Christianity and Islam.

This changed after Zionist Jews started migrating into Palestine becoming landlords of farms where they acted like lords and beat Arabs with whips. This demonstrates the inherent racism present in Zionism.

[Zionists] did not regard the fellahin as human beings; and for every small thing they beat and punish them with whips.

They behave hostilely (sic) and cruelly toward the Arabs, encroaching upon them unjustly, beating them disgracefully for no good reason, and then they do not hesitate to boast about their deeds.

The Zionist press continually denounced the Arabs as: 'murderers', bands of robbers', 'bloodthirsty rioters', 'desert savages', 'jackals', highway robbers', 'treacherous murders', 'barbarians', 'savages' and so on. This is in contrast to Gentile visitors who have found the Palestinians to be among the nicest people anywhere in the world.

The Balfour Declaration (2 November 1917)

Arthur Balfour, the British foreign secretary, wrote a letter to Lord (baron) Rothschild in 1917 stating that Britain favoured the creation of a homeland for Jews in Palestine.

Jewish immigration was encouraged by the Balfour Declaration but only a trickle of Jews migrated there. By 1920 Jews only owned 2% of Palestine. At this time there was peace in Palestine with Muslims, Christians, Druze and others living peacefully in small villages eking out a rural lifestyle (though Zionist Jewish landlords were cruel to Arab workers). Jews were happier to live in modern societies in the West, especially America. However, immigration increased greatly in 1948 when the State of Israel was established.

The declaration stated: 'It being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine'. This was ignored.

The Palestinians

The Palestinians are a varied group of people that have lived in Palestine for centuries, generally peacefully. They are chiefly Arabs but with different religious foundations. A significant minority are Christians but the majority are Muslim. 90% of Palestinians are Christians or Muslims. 35% of the whole population is Christian. Christians and Muslims worship side by side without animosity. The rest include Druze and smaller minorities, including some Jews.

Since they are Arabs, they have a direct link to Abraham through Ishmael. God originally promised the land to Abraham. Most modern Jews are not Semitic and do not have a direct link to Abraham (see earlier and later). Even so, the promise to Abraham was really a heavenly country, not an earthly tract of land (Heb 11:16). The promise is centred in Christ (Gal 3:16); in a heavenly kingdom (2 Tim 4:18).

Westerners that have lived amongst the Palestinians all testify that they are a gracious, courteous, traditional people, despite living in poverty. Examples would be Vanessa Beeley, Eva Bartlett and Max Igan.

The claims of Joan Peters ('From Time Immemorial') that most Palestinians in now occupied Jewish territory were not indigenous but had migrated there for economic advantages during the British mandate, have been thoroughly dismissed as fake, forgery and plagiarism by Norman Finkelstein.

British mandate (1920–48)

The name 'Palestine' was used as the official political title for the land west of the Jordan mandated to Britain in 1920. Note: Palestine was never part of the British Empire. It was mandated by treaty as a caretaker temporary government.

Under the British mandate in Palestine the Jewish community increased from about 10 per cent of the population in 1918 to about 30 per cent in 1936.

Israeli terrorism during the mandate

The Israeli army (IDF: Israeli Defence Force) was formed out of the terrorist groups the Irgun and the Stern Gang.

- Haganah: largest terrorist militia that continued in association with the British.
- Irgun: a right-wing Zionist organisation founded in 1931 that split off from the Haganah and was opposed to Britain. During the period when it was active (1937–48) it carried out violent attacks on Arabs and Britons in its campaign to establish a Jewish state; it was disbanded after the creation of Israel in 1948 but absorbed into the IDF.
- Stern Gang: the British name for the militant Zionist group Lehi that campaigned in Palestine during the 1940s for the creation of a Jewish state. Founded by Avraham Stern (1907–42) as an offshoot of Irgun, the group assassinated the British Minister for the Middle East, Lord Moyne, and Count Bernadotte, the UN mediator for Palestine.

You can find newsreels of British soldiers capturing Israel terrorist gangs (including men and women) for trial and ultimately execution for mass murder.

United Nations 1945

This international organisation of countries was set up in 1945, in succession to the League of Nations with headquarters in New York. It claims to promote international peace, security, and co-operation. Its members, originally the countries that fought against the Axis in World War II, numbered 186 in 1995 and include most sovereign states of the world.

The UN supported the provision of Jewish homeland in Palestine under a completely unworkable two-state concept. In 1937 the Peel Commission had recommended the partition of Palestine and the formation of Jewish and Arab states. Subsequently Britain abandoned the partition solution, but, after its referral of the Palestine problem to the United Nations in 1947, a United Nations Special Commission recommended partition and a resolution to that effect passed the General Assembly.

Bear in mind that this resolution had no legal status whatsoever; it was a recommendation only.

After the 1947 UN resolution, 3/4 million Arabs fled their homes. Arabs insist that this was an expulsion by militant Zionist Jews. Israelis aver that this resulted from the advice of invading Arab leaders to flee. In fact, As Finkelstein proves, 'evidence points to the conclusion that Palestine's Arabs were expelled systematically and with premeditation'. Arab leaders did not order an exodus.

1947-1948: the land possessed

Ethnic cleansing

Between November 1947 and November 1948, 531 Palestinian towns and villages were ethnically cleansed by Jews. By 1952 it was 615.

A virgin wilderness?

The Zionist trope that the land was a virgin wilderness with a thin population that did not work the land and therefore did not deserve it, is also a lie. Palestine was essentially rural communities, with small farms being worked by families who had held them for generations. These farms were taken over and the residents killed or forced to flee.

A similar argument was used by the English to take over North America¹⁰ or Ireland and many others since. Note the Zionist propaganda, 'A land without a people for a people without a land.'¹¹ Or, 'From the first moment of the Zionist idea, Zionist propaganda described the land to which we were headed as desolate and forsaken, impatiently waiting for its redeemers ... Palestine was a virgin country'.¹² How anyone could have believed this nonsense is amazing; the Fertile Crescent had been worked for millennia. Jericho is one of the oldest cities in ancient history. The Bible explains that each man had his own vineyard and agriculture was required to bring in the grain offerings. In the case of America, the original Pilgrim fathers were rescued during a heavy winter by the Indians who gave them corn.

In the case of Palestine, all the land available for cultivation was already being worked by the indigenous people. ¹³ Even Jews countered Zionist propaganda: 'in our beloved land there lives an entire people that has been dwelling there for many centuries and has never considered leaving it'. ¹⁴ 'Palestine belongs to others and it is totally settled.' ¹⁵

After the occupation in 1948 the Zionists rewrote the history of Palestine ruling the indigenous people out and formulating the mythological message that Jews owned the land by divine right. The 'blossoming forth' of the land by Jews, such as by irrigation channels using US aid finance, was proof of divine favour. Propaganda like this

proliferated in messianic Christian journals, magazines, tracts and sermons so that American Christians in particular completely accepted the myth. For example, 'The Jews have no aspirations to rule in Palestine – they are coming to colonise the wilderness and to develop regions that have to date been unploughed.'16

Self-defence

Another lie that was cast into mythology by Zionist propaganda was that the violence perpetrated by Jewish forces (terrorists) was done in self-defence. This neatly eliminates from the historical record the fact that Jews pushed families out of their houses, lined them up against the wall and shot them all. One survivor, who was saved by standing in front of a relative when very young, recalled such a scene.¹⁷ Entire villages were massacred in this way. No other nation could get away with such genocide; worse still, claim that it is a victim of the people it murdered. This was planned from the beginning of Zionism, 'In blood and fire shall Judea rise again' was the proposed slogan for a Jewish Legion.¹⁸

Violence against Arabs was anticipated long before 1948 and planned for. Ben Gurion repeatedly mentioned, going back to 1937, that a strong Jewish force would be necessary to gain their historical goal. For example, 'after we become a strong force, as a result of the creation of a state, we shall abolish partition and expand to the whole of Palestine' (1938). 'I' [The Jewish State] will have an outstanding army ... and so I am certain that we won't be constrained from settling in the rest of the country. '20 'The slogan Jewish State ... is equivalent, in effect, to a declaration of War by the Jews on the Arabs.'21

Even Ben Gurion's biographer is forced to admit that Ben Gurion merely publicly advocated rapprochement with the Arabs to satisfy the British but his private view was war with the Arabs to steal their land. He affirmed that, at the very least, the establishment of a Jewish state was political aggression which the Arabs were forced to confront aggressively. This reaction could enable military force using the excuse of self-defence.

Zionism had long decided that violence and terror was necessary to subdue the local population, taking its lead from the ethics and tactics of Soviet Socialism.

A historical mission liberates its bearers from the restrictions of simple morality in the name of higher justice.

The use of force [was legitimate] for the sake of generating the desired revolutionary change.

Every revolutionary ideology harbours within it the legitimation for the use of violence, since the end justified the means.

During the Arab revolt of 1936-39 the Irgun Zvai Leumi engaged in, 'the uninhibited use of terror'; 'mass indiscriminate killings of the aged, women and children'; 'the extortion of funds and acts of robbery ... in the Jewish community in order to finance their actions'; 'attacks against British without any consideration of possible injuries to innocent bystanders, and the murder of British in cold blood'.²²

1948: Eretz Israel established

The British mandate ended on 14 May 1948 and the independent Jewish State of Israel in Palestine was established by diktat. By 1948 Jews held **6%** of Palestine.

The creation of the state was opposed by the Palestinian Arabs supported by Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, and Egypt, but after a violent conflict Israel survived and considerably enlarged its territory at the expense of the proposed Arab state. The actions of Israel in this war were war crimes; entire villages were massacred.

A substantial Palestinian refugee problem was created as many Arabs fled from Israel-controlled territory.

The Jewish lies used to gain Palestinian territory after 1948

- The lie that Palestine was largely unoccupied.
- The lie that Palestine was an un-worked wilderness.
- The lie that 750,000 Palestinians fled their homes during the ethnic cleansing by Jewish militias in 1948 because Arab leaders told them to do so.
- The lie that it was Arab leaders that started the 1948 war that saw Israel take **75**% of Palestinian land.²³
- The lie that Jews were only interested in developing un-worked land and that military violence was self-defence against Arab aggression.
- The lie that violence was never considered before 1948. (Jews were even massacring Arabs during the mandate.)

The nation established

After 1948 immigration into Israel increased from over 100 different nations, especially from Communist and Arab countries raising the population from about 700,000 in 1948 to 5.3 million by 1994.

Despite high inflation, Israel's economy is the most industrialised in the region, greatly aided by huge funding from the USA and also from European powers.

Expansion

Over the last 70 years Israel has continually stolen land from the Palestinians to occupy almost all of Palestine, far from the original plan of a small section of land in 1948. This theft has included many forms: destroying entire villages; bulldozing homes; exploding tower blocks; arbitrarily stealing individual Palestinian homes illegally (Jews just walk in and change the locks); creating settlements in Palestinian-owned land, and so on. Jews claim publicly that God gave them this land, this house, this tower block – and so they take it.

Violations

- The land grabs are illegal and violate UN Charter, Article 2(4) and 51 (1945). Declaration on Principles of International Law concerning friendly relations, principle 1 (1970).
- Settlements on occupied land violate the Geneva Conventions IV, Article 49(6) (1949).

Israel also has more UN security resolutions against it than any other nation.

Israeli-Arab wars

1956 Suez War

Egypt nationalised the Suez Canal Company by Egypt in 1956. Attempts to establish an international authority to operate the Canal failed so Britain and France entered into a military agreement with Israel. On 29 October Israel launched a surprise attack into Sinai, and Britain and France issued an ultimatum demanding that both Israel and Egypt should withdraw from the Canal. This was rejected by President Nasser. British and French planes attacked Egyptian bases, and troops were landed at Port Said. Under pressure from the USA, with the collapse of the value of sterling, and mounting criticism of most other nations, the Anglo-French operations were halted and their forces evacuated. A UN peace-keeping force was sent to the area. The US Secretary of State, J. F. Dulles, formulated the short-lived Eisenhower Doctrine (1957), offering US economic and military aid to Middle East governments whose independence was threatened. Israeli forces were withdrawn in March 1957 after an agreement to install a UN Emergency Force in Sinai and to open the Straits of Tiran to Israeli shipping. [Sic, Oxford World Encyclopaedia.]

1967 Six-Day War, 10 June 1967

Israel started this war under the pretence of national security. In fact it began with Israel attacking Sammu in the West Bank (Jordan) followed by an aerial border skirmish with Syria followed by announcements of potential war with Syria. It had also continually taken over Arab villages, expelling the residents, in the Golan Heights DMZ.

Despite Jordan taking steps to hinder Arab terrorism it was also threatened by Israel. Egypt had been slow to offer any support to Arab action against Israel but was forced to expel the UN from Sinai and establish a token military presence. Egypt and Jordan were in no position to wage a war with Israel and sought to prevent it.

Meanwhile various parties, notably America and the UN, were engaged in trying to deescalate the build up and a peaceful settlement seemed probable – until Israel invaded Egypt pre-emptively.

Israel occupied Sinai, the Old City of Jerusalem, the West Bank, and the Golan Heights and defeated an Egyptian, Jordanian, and Syrian alliance with American help. Israel took the remaining 22% of Palestinian land plus areas owned by Egypt and Syria.

12 March 1970

Israel invaded South Lebanon.

1973 Yom Kippur War (October War)

The cause of this was that Israel refused to return stolen territory gained from the 1967 war, despite pressure from the UN and the US to do so.

The war began on 6 October, the Feast of Yom Kippur and lasted three weeks. Egyptian forces crossed the Suez Canal and breached the Israeli Bar Lev Line. Syrian troops forced

back Israeli forces on the Golan Heights. Israel pushed Syrian forces back into Syria and crossed the Canal, encircling an Egyptian army. In the aftermath, disengagement agreements were signed by Israel with Syria in 1974 and with Egypt in 1974 and 1975. The Israeli withdrawal from Sinai was completed in 1982 after the 1978 Israeli—Egyptian peace treaty.

1982 Lebanon War

The activities of the PLO initiated an Israeli military invasion and led to Israeli occupation (1978) of a part of southern Lebanon. A UN peace-keeping force attempted unsuccessfully to set up a buffer zone. A full military invasion (1982) by Israel led to the evacuation of the Palestinians. A massacre by the Phalangist Christian militia in Israeli-occupied West Beirut of Muslim civilians in the Chabra and Chatila refugee camps brought a redeployment of UN peace-keeping forces. Syria again intervened in 1987, but many problems remained unresolved. Israel established a South Lebanon Army (SLA), and there were 20 Israeli air-raids during 1988. [Oxford World Encyclopaedia.]

As a result of these wars Israel extended its occupation to include all the territory of the former British mandate.

Many towns and villages were destroyed creating many refugees. Eight initial air raids killed 1,000 people. In July jets destroyed part of the densely populated Fakahani district of Beirut. 200 were killed and 800 wounded. 40% were small children. The invasion of Beirut lasted 80 days destroying much of the city. Massacres occurred at Sabra and Shatila refugee camps. 2,500 plus Palestinian women, children and elderly people were killed. Israeli air force bombing of Lebanon in 1982 killed 17,000 Arab civilians.

Israel and the Palestinians - post war politics²⁴

- 1986–92: The right-wing leader of the Likud Party, Prime Minister Yitzhak Shamir, led a government firmly opposed to any concessions over the Palestine problem.
- 1991–92: Yitzhak Rabin (Labour leader) made progress towards an eventual settlement. Intense diplomatic efforts, led by the USA, resulted in several sessions of Middle East peace talks.
- Late 1992: Arab—Israeli peace talks were disrupted by violent clashes between Palestinians and Israeli security forces in the occupied territories and by the deportation of over 400 Palestinians, causing the PLO to halt negotiations.
- 1993: Despite the escalating violence in the occupied territories in 1993, Middle East peace talks resumed but remained deadlocked. An unexpected breakthrough in negotiations between Israel and the PLO, led by Yasser Arafat, resulted in a declaration of principles on Palestinian self-rule in the occupied territories. The declaration was welcomed internationally as a significant step forward in the peace process, while there was widespread opposition from right-wing Israeli political groups. Israel signed a peace treaty with Jordan in 1994 and had withdrawn its forces from all Jordanian territories by early 1995.
- 1995: The issue of Jewish settlement in the occupied West Bank, a long-standing source of dispute, sparked a crisis in the peace process in 1995. The assassination of Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin in November by a Jewish extremist cast doubt over the future and once again threw the Middle East peace process into confusion. Shimon Peres succeeded Rabin.
- 1996: Hamas launched a number of suicide bomb attacks on Israeli cities.
- 1996 (May): Peres, a supporter of the peace process, lost to the hawkish Binyamin Netanyahu, furthering the fundamentalist causes on both sides, for whom the peace process was unacceptable. Since then, no progress has been made in the peace process.

Who owns Israel?

Israeli terrorism

UN resolutions

Israel has more UN Security Council resolutions against it for atrocities than any other nation. Israel has officially violated legally binding resolutions: 54, 111, 233, 234, 236, 248, 250, 252, 256, 262, 267, 270, 280, 285, 298, 313, 316, 468, 476, and more.

Comparative military resources

Israel

Note that Israel has some of the most advanced weapons and munitions in the world, mostly supplied by the US and NATO. It has an army (IDF), an air force and a navy plus a very advanced intelligence service (Mossad).

Mossad has an annual budget of \$3 billion and 7,000 staff. It is the second largest espionage agency in the western world after the CIA. Yet Israel is a very small nation. One Mossad doctrine is 'Justified Vengeance' initiated in 2001.²⁵ This is the cornerstone of Israeli intelligence principles. This justifies acts of genocide with the support of the international community. The current Hamas-Israel War is a typical example of this. Mossad's mandate is to create divisions between Palestinian factions and continue fear through routine false flag operations against Israelis to sustain Justified Vengeance policies.

The Palestinians

The Palestinians have no intelligence service, no army, no air force and no navy. Their weapons are mostly of poor quality with limited effect; some are home made. Effectively some rockets plus small arms. The majority of the population is children.

Pre 1948

- In November 1940: Zionists sank the ship Patria carrying 1,800 Jewish refugees headed for Mauritius but the Haganah (Palestinian Jewish terrorists led by Ben Gurion) sank it.
- Zionists sank the ship Struma killing 760 Jews.
- In 1946 Zionists (the Irgun, Haganah and the Jewish Agency) blew up the King David Hotel in Jerusalem killing 91 people, injuring over 200 people. Planned by Menachem Begin who was later awarded a Nobel Peace Prize.
- Between 1946 and 1948 there were multiple Zionist terrorist attacks: bombs thrown at
 Arab buses in Haifa killing 12; bombs thrown at an Arab café in Jaffa; bombs thrown at
 the Damascus Gate, Jerusalem killing two British police officers and 11 Arabs; mortars
 used on Arab villages; the Semiramis Hotel blown up killing 20; the Cairo-Haifa
 Express was mined killing 40 people; many gunned down, etc. There were dozens more
 examples.

The Nakba

Post 1948

- February 1949: Israel invades Egypt to the Gulf of Aqaba, occupying Umm Rashrash, which they rename Eilat.
- 1950: Israel invaded Al-Uja de-militarised zone in Egypt and Baqqara in Syria, destroying Arab homes.
- Since Arabs refused to sell their homeland, Jews resorted to terrorism. The first major act was at the village of Deir Yassin on 9 April 1948. The Irgun and The Stern Gang attacked and massacred over 250 men, women and children. This attack was led by Menachem Begin, who, as President later, openly declared this a necessary victory.
- Jews killed 60 Palestinians at Balad Esh Sheikh.
- Jews blew up 20 homes in Sa'sa, killing 60 women and children.
- Jews massacred 250-400 at Lydda. 350 died in the following forced march.
- Jews killed 200, mostly old people, in the village mosque in Ed-Dawayimeh.
- Jews killed 51 workers as they returned from their fields.
- Between 1948 and 1984, 350 Christian churches and Muslim mosques were destroyed.
- 1950-1955 over 40 military acts by Israel against Arab states.
- Cairo, July 1954. Israel sabotage operations fire-bombed the Alexandrian post office (14 July) and the US Information Agency offices in Cairo and Alexandria and a British theatre using phosphorous incendiaries.
- 1966: Israeli soldiers kill 18 civilians and wound 100 in the village of Sammu in Jordan. They also demolished 130 houses, a school, a clinic and a mosque.
- 1969. Israeli war planes raided an Egyptian school 'Bahr al Baker' killing 65 schoolchildren and wounding 200.
- 8 September 1972. Israeli warplanes bombed Palestinians in Lebanon and Syria killing many civilians.
- 21 February 1973. Israeli commandos attacked Palestinian refugee camps in Lebanon and blew up houses. 35 refugees were killed. The same day Israeli warplanes shot down a Libyan Civilian aircraft over the Sinai desert killing over 100 passengers.
- 10 April 1973 Israeli commandos stormed East Beirut killing three PLO leaders.
- 1974. Israeli units attacked Beirut airport destroying 13 Lebanese aircraft.
- 1975-1980. Mossad agents assassinated a number of Arab and Palestinian diplomats, scientists and journalists.
- 1986. Mossad agents assassinate a Palestinian cartoonist in London.
- April 1988. Israeli commandos murdered Khalil Al Wazir in Tunis while sleeping.
- 1981. Israeli warplanes destroyed an Iragi civilian nuclear reactor.
- 1985. Israeli planes destroyed the PLO HQ in Tunis.
- 1989 Israeli F-16s bomb targets in Lebanon killing 15 school children in Damour.

- 27 February 1994, a bomb placed in the Maronite Catholic Church in Junieh, Lebanon killed ten Catholics and wounded 60 others. The Lebanese Prime Minister Rafik al-Hariri and others stated that Mossad was the guilty party.
- 2012: During a three-year period, a journalist for the Guardian reported in 2012 that the Israeli army killed more than 400 children, half in Rafah and Khan Yunis. A quarter was under the age of 12.26 An investigation of several deaths revealed that there was no combat, just cold-blooded murder. In one case a girl aged 12 was killed as she walked home from school; in another an 11-year old boy was shot as he played football. But this is in accordance with the Talmud's command to kill Gentiles and their children, which are considered as sub-human animals. We could document hundreds more examples of war crimes committed against Palestinians. After one soldier was investigated, in a whitewash enquiry, for pumping many bullets into a 12-year old girl too close to a fence, he said he would have happily done it if she was three! He was exonerated.

IDF methods

The IDF often shoots to kill by a shot in the head; very often children are the targets. But there is also a shoot to maim policy and kidnapping. Here are some methods used to terrorise Palestinians.

- Breaking both arms of prisoners. This can be seen in a John Pilger documentary.
- Shooting people in the elbow or kneecap to maim for life.
- Shooting boys in the groin to prevent them ever having children.
- Shooting girls in the vagina to prevent childbirth.
- Kidnapping children off the street for organ trafficking. You can find videos of young boys being stolen off the street.
- Shooting pregnant women in the belly.
- Gouging out eyes.
- Chopping fingers off children.

Israeli false flags

The foundation of Israeli false flags is the combined actions of:

- Mossad: Foreign Intelligence.
- Shin Bet: Domestic National Security.
- Aman: Military Intelligence.

Israel has not only infiltrated Hamas and the Palestinian National Authority but controls Al-Qaeda, ISIS and Daesh. Note how ISIS casualties in the Syrian conflict were taken to Israel hospitals for treatment.

Many more false flags are suspected but these below are proven.

Baghdad 1950

Mossad agents launched a wave of false flag terrorist bombings against Jewish targets in Baghdad. This persuaded Iraq's 1,000-year old Jewish community to emigrate to Israel.

The Beirut Marine Barracks bombing

The 23 October 1983 suicide bombing attack on the US Marine barracks in Lebanon killed 241 Marine personnel. This was planned by Mossad. The purpose was to turn the American people against the Arabs in order to draw the USA into the war to help Israel.²⁷

The Lavon Affair

In 1954 the US was beginning to court Egypt rather than Israel. To divert the US from this, Mossad decided to use 11 agents in Egypt to blow up American buildings blaming it on Egyptian nationalists. However, the conspiracy was discovered, exposed and named 'the Lavon Affair', after the defence Minster Pinhas Lavon who allegedly masterminded it. Lavon denied involvement but blamed Mossad. Israel's culpability was never doubted.

The attempted sinking of the USS Liberty

This was a US intelligence gathering vessel sailing in international waters. On 8 June 1967, during the Six-Day War, Israel used unmarked military fighter-bombers to attack the American reconnaissance ship USS Liberty, along with three torpedo boats, which fired six torpedoes. Unmarked jets are a violation of the Geneva Convention.

The attack lasted 75 minutes and included machine gun / cannon fire, missiles and napalm bombs. The attack followed 13 close up Israeli reconnaissance sorties. Miraculously, the ship was not sunk, but it did have a large gaping hole in the side. When life rafts were launched, they were immediately shot up by machine gun fire from the aircraft. The intent was clearly to leave no survivors. An Israeli helicopter gun ship waited nearby expecting the Liberty to sink; this was presumed to be to machine gun any survivors in the water. With no survivors the Israelis could easily blame Egyptian Arabs.

Thirty-four American sailors were killed and 172 wounded in the attack.

Israel claimed that it was a case of mistaken identity. To say that this is implausible is an understatement; it is risible. US intelligence claimed that it was a deliberate attack ordered by General Moshe Dyan. This was confirmed by former Secretary of State Dean Rusk and former Joint Chief of Staff Admiral Thomas Moorer.²⁸

1981

A huge wave of false-flag terrorist attacks was unleashed by Israeli Defence minister Ariel Sharon, managed by a former high-ranking Mossad official. Car bombs went off in Palestinian neighbourhoods of Beirut and other Lebanese cities, killing many. One attack alone in October caused nearly 400 casualties. By December there were 18 bombings a month. This was to provoke a military response by the PLO thereby giving cause for Israel to invade the country as per Sharon's plan.

Timeline of Israeli plans to eradicate the Palestinians

- **1993-95**: Failure of peace negotiations (Oslo I and Oslo II (1993-95) Assassination of Yitzhak Rabin (1995).
- **2001**: Operation Justified Vengeance. [See 'Israeli terrorism' in this document.]
- **2002**: Decision to build the separating wall isolating Gaza by the Sharon government.
- **2004**: Assassination of Yasser Arafat. Undertaken by Mossad and ordered by the Israeli Cabinet in 2003. Supported by the US, which vetoed a UN security resolution condemning the 2003 decision.
- **2005**: Removal of all Jewish settlers in Gaza by Ariel Sharon. 7,000 people were relocated in order to transform the Gaza Strip into an open-air prison camp. Sanctions and attacks could not take place with Jewish settlers present.
- **2006**: The Hamas Election victory. This stopped Fatah leader Mahmoud Abbas from unifying the Palestinians.
- **2008-2009**: Operation Cast lead. 'Bloodshed Justification'. Killing of Palestinian civilians who were deliberately targeted. Bombing campaign and ground invasion of Gaza. A part of the Justified Vengeance doctrine. Plans for the onslaught were made whilst peace negotiations were being planned. Food, fuel and medical supplies cut off.
- **2023**: Hamas-Israeli War.

The ruthless persecution of the Gaza Strip

Gaza has been a concentration camp for decades; they are trapped between the sea and the Israeli fortified fence. The population of over 2 million people is relentlessly persecuted. Food supplies are restricted; electricity is rationed; water is restricted; medicines are in very short supply. A third of the people affected by this are children. 50% of the population is aged 14. 75% of the population is 25 years old or younger. Most of the Palestinians in Gaza fled there from Israeli occupation of their homes.

They have poor resources. Their rockets are low powered Kassam rockets. They have no tanks, no air force, and no military vehicles. They have AK47 rifles, no body armour and home made munitions. There is no war between equal parties.

Missile strikes and bombing runs, in retaliation for a moderate Hamas attack, kill thousands every time. Civilian areas are mostly targeted, including schools, hospitals and residential tower blocks. Israel has also dropped white sulphur bombs on Gaza. Palestinians have no defence against Israeli missiles or bombs.

Methods of persecution

- Cut off the water supply.
- Pollute the water supply.
- Establish an embargo on food supplies since 2007.
- Deny medical supplies.
- Deny power supplies.
- Denial of fuel.
- Shooting civilians too close to boundary fences.
- Missile strikes on Palestinian structures.
- Bombing raids.
- Strict control of all borders. No one gets in or out.

This has been going on for years, decades. Gaza is an open-air prison camp. A blockade of civilians is a war crime.

Terrorise the civilian population, assuring maximal destruction of property and cultural resources ... The daily life of the Palestinians must be rendered unbearable; they should be locked up in cities and towns, prevented from exercising normal economic life, cut off from workplaces, schools and hospitals. This will encourage emigration and weaken the resistance to future expulsions.

Hamas

The standard history

The Oxford Dictionary definition of Hamas is as follows: 'a Palestinian Islamic fundamentalist movement that has become a focus for Arab resistance in the Israeli-occupied territories. It opposes peace with Israel and has come into conflict with the more moderate Palestine Liberation Organisation'.

Officially, The Islamic Resistance Movement (Hamas is an acronym) was founded in 1976 by Sheikh Yassin Ahmed, to create an Islamic state in Palestine.

It was originally non-militant, but became increasingly violent during the 1990s. It was opposed to the peace process between Israel and the PLO and deployed suicide bombings in 1996, with many Israelis killed. This resulted in Israeli political hawks voting out the

peace-seeking Shimon Peres and establishing the right-wing, severe hawk Binyamin Netanyahu.

The deeper history

Background

There are 17 resistance groups operating in Gaza promoting Palestinian nationalism.

Hamas is primarily the political aspect of The Islamic Resistance Movement. The military characteristic is a separate organisation, the Izz ad-Din al-Qassam brigades. There is also a social service wing, Dawah.

Hamas was created by the Israelis with the support of the CIA to harass Yasser Arafat who was making political gains and split Palestinian factions from unifying.²⁹ The intention also appears to be to provoke Israeli resentment in order to excuse military attacks on Palestinian territories especially Gaza. It certainly allowed Netanyahu to gain control of Israeli politics and pursue a very hard line against the Palestinians. Recently Israeli spokesmen stated that Hamas was an asset to Israel.³⁰

In 2005 the Israeli's officially withdrew from the Gaza Strip and handed it over to the Palestinians. However, most Jews, and certainly Netanyahu, believe that Gaza belongs to Jews and seek to regain the territory. Claiming that Gaza is a hotbed of terrorism fomented by Hamas enables Israel to constantly attack the area and establish an embargo.

The Hamas-Mossad partnership was established in 1987 and this is confirmed by Netanyahu:

Anyone who wants to thwart the establishment of a Palestinian state has to support bolstering Hamas and transferring money to Hamas ... This is part of our strategy – to isolate the Palestinians in Gaza from the Palestinians in the West Bank'

This was confirmed by the Times of Israel.

Hamas was treated as a partner to the detriment of the Palestinian Authority to prevent Abbas from moving towards creating a Palestinian State. Hamas was promoted from a terrorist group to an organisation with which Israel conducted negotiations through Egypt, and which was allowed to receive suitcases containing millions of dollars from Qatar through the Gaza crossings.

Stealing all Palestinian land – the goal

The goal is the total appropriation of Palestinian land and the exclusion of the Palestinian people from their homeland.

The Hamas / Israeli War

Claims of Hamas barbarity refuted; IDF atrocities confirmed

The start of the Hamas / Israel War on 7 October 2023 was a combined attack by al-Qassam plus an Israeli false flag operation.

Incredibly, Hamas gained entry into Israel and conducted terrorist attacks supposedly killing hundreds. The Jewish-owned mainstream media whipped this up in the West with stories of barbarism and brutality, some events being proved to be false. As usual,³¹ claims of brutalised babies surfaced.

- The story of beheaded babies was false, as even Joe Biden was forced to admit.
- The claim that Hamas roasted babies in ovens was clearly false; no evidence was provided.
- The story of Hamas para-gliders was false; film shows that these were parachutes. Parachutes require aeroplanes but Hamas has no aircraft. Gaza has no resources. You cannot get crayons or A4 paper let alone a para-glider.
- The high number of Israelis killed by Hamas (1400) was false. There were multiple allegations by Israelis that IDF soldiers had killed other Israelis; some were friendly-fire incidents.
- 28 Israeli Apache helicopter gunships attacked 300 targets for four hours, especially at the music concert. Videos emerged showing that it was impossible for pilots to distinguish who the targets were. Many Israelis were killed by these helicopters. Israelis killed multiple civilians. The burned bodies were caused by Israeli missiles. Various pilots have testified that they were instructed to shoot and bomb targets with no intelligence whatsoever, being unable to distinguish between militants and civilians.
- Testimonies later emerged from Israelis that the IDF shot at Israeli homes, and burned alive Israeli citizens. Hamas only targeted military personnel.³² IDF indiscriminate fire killed Israelis while trying to neutralise Hamas military units. Homes were shelled by tanks killing civilians as well as terrorists. Haaretz reported that it was the IDF high command that instructed soldiers to attack homes and civilians in order to repel the terrorists.³³ There is confirmed video footage showing IDF shooting civilians with Kalashnikov rifles.³⁴ The purpose was to cause mass deaths and blame it on Hamas to provoke war.
- Regarding the music festival, one survivor, Yasmin Porat, took refuge in Kibbutz Be'en, She testified that on Israeli State radio that the Hamas militants were nice to her and the other hostages, but it was IDF soldiers that shot and killed Israelis.³⁵ The Be'en death toll was 112, killed by the IDF.
- The raped girl and the bombed cars published at the beginning of the crisis were later proved to be performed by the IDF.
- The number of Israeli hostages kept changing. They were also treated well, as admitted by a freed hostage who shook the hand of her captor. [Hostages were used to stop Israeli bombing raids.]
- The claim that Hamas used Palestinian children as human shields was also false but footage has emerged of Israeli soldiers doing exactly that. There is no forensic evidence that Palestinians have ever used human shields but there are multiple forms of evidence that Israel has been doing that for decades, even going back to the British

mandate. Children are regularly used as human shields by the IDF and you can find video evidence of this. The children are then tortured and imprisoned.³⁶ Some have organs removed.

The self-defence excuse

In international law Gaza is defined as an occupied territory, Israel is the occupying power and therefore has no legal right to self-defence under international law and the Geneva Conventions. This was confirmed by Richard A Falk, emeritus professor of international law at Princeton; chair of the Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Monitor.³⁷

This was further confirmed by a UN Commissioner for Human Rights, Francesca Albanese. She cites UN Charter 51, which states that self-defence is permissible solely to repel an armed attack by another state. Israel can protect itself but not wage war on the occupied territory. She said that Israel's attacks were disproportionate and violate the principle of precaution. It cannot bomb hospitals and schools.

Despite this, Western leaders, notably Rishi Sunak, stated that Israel had every right to engage in warfare because of self-defence.

Western leadership support but population dissent

The West wholeheartedly supported Israel and pro-Palestinian demonstrations were treated with derision, anger and calls for arrests. Even crusaders of free speech, such as Toby Young, called for the termination of Palestinian chanting - so greatly are westerners conditioned by Israeli propaganda.

This support enabled Israel to immediately conduct war crimes by missile attacks and bombing runs. Immediately two schools and two hospitals were attacked with no mention by the BBC.

Despite this pro-Israel support, protests and huge demonstrations erupted all over the world, including London. One London demonstration was the largest ever seen, hundreds of thousands marched. These were largely peaceful containing all sorts of people of all ages, creeds and race. They even included Jewish groups supporting Gaza. Nevertheless the media portrayed these as hate mobs and used made-up stories of attacks. People that were at the early November demonstration in London found them peaceful and controlled.³⁸

The al-Ahli Hospital

Then the al-Ahli Hospital was obliterated and the Jewish-run press claimed that it was caused by a Hamas misdirected rocket.

This was proved to be false; no Hamas rocket has such firepower. Hamas rockets do not have warheads. Originally the Israeli's admitted the strike in a Tweet (now deleted but screen shots are available) claiming that there was a Hamas base situated there and it was a legitimate target. Then it claimed that a Hamas rocket was launched but misfired and exploded in the sky falling on the hospital crating an explosion. This is not possible, as there is no warhead. Also an Israeli warplane was filmed firing flares above the hospital to create the background for the misfired rocket story.

Furthermore, there is no crater at the explosion site. This is because the missile fired by Israel was a US JDAM missile,³⁹ which appears to have exploded in the air above the target and did not leave a crater. The sound analysis of the explosion is identified as a guided missile. The hospital was deliberately targeted.

Since at least three hospitals have been targeted by Israel, along with at least two schools, it appears that the intention is to kill as many civilians as possible. The Israeli Army released a video showing attacks. It said that it hit over 100 targets in one night's bombing.

While the west mourned Israeli casualties it ignored the far greater numbers of Palestinian casualties, especially children. You can see videos of Israeli missiles destroying whole residential tower blocks one after another. Thousands of families are being destroyed daily. This is genocide. In addition Israel cut off water and electricity supplies so that hospitals cannot function. The intention is genocide.

Other civilian areas are being struck such as cafes and markets, including supermarkets. Some children were bombed playing near a water tank.

Israel also killed over 50 war correspondents and 11 UN peace-workers by early November. Israel also killed multiple foreign aid workers. Leaders of US aid teams have issued videos explaining the American tax dollars have been used to kill US citizens who came to help injured people.

Several other hospitals have been destroyed; you can find video footage of missiles targeting them. The Indonesian hospital was destroyed.

A planned false flag

But how did Hamas gain access to the most defended area in the world? How did the most efficient intelligence network have no warning and no defence? It is unthinkable. This was a planned false flag operation in order to justify war with Gaza and annexing the territory.

- There are so many hi-tech sensor devices on the fences that a cat will trigger alarms.
- Sensors and barriers are also placed in the underground tunnels.
- Yet the border was open, no alarms raised.
- The defence forces had withdrawn. They were sent to the West Bank for 'security concerns' that left the Gaza border open. Between 60-80% of that area had no IDF forces.
- The fence was breached with no Israeli response. This is unthinkable. For decades soldiers had killed Palestinian children for merely getting too near the fence.
- Multiple videos emerged of testimonies from former IDF soldiers that this breach was impossible unless it had been allowed to occur.
- In addition Egypt had warned of the coming attack four days before it occurred.
- Netanyahu was under extreme political pressure and needed a big galvanising patriotic event. He was being investigated for corruption amidst many claims for him to be replaced.

The 'surprise attack' was nothing but a planned operation.

The plan: destroy Gaza

Clearly Israel allowed Hamas to gain access and commit terrorist attacks so that it could then have reason for an all-out attack on Gaza to destroy over 2 million people and annex the land (which it has always wanted). There are even allegations that the IDF also killed its own citizens.

This is why Hamas was created. It is a means to enable Israel to attack Gaza.

Two weeks before the attack Netanyahu held up a map in the UN General Assembly showing the 'New Middle East'. The map showed the elimination of Gaza and all Palestinian regions.

As Israel prepared for a ground war, Israeli Defence Minister, Yaov Gallant, told troops, 'We have abolished the rules of war. Our soldiers will not be held responsible for anything. There will be no military courts. ... I have released all the restraints ... we are moving to a full offence. ... Gaza will never return to what it was.'. Israeli Defence Force spokesman, Jonathan Conricus declared that Israel would, 'raze every building to the ground in revenge for Hamas'. Clearly the plan is genocide.

By the end of October there were officially more than 6,500 Palestinian deaths, but hundreds of thousands missing.

Threat of WWIII

The possibilities for this triggering WWIII are immense. Hezbollah has stated that if Israel starts a ground offensive it will defend the Palestinians and if necessary start a war with Israel, including using cruise missiles from its fleet. In return the US said that if so, then they will start a war with Hezbollah. The Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps then publicly stated that it was ready to go to war with Israel as part of a joint operation with Hezbollah. Turkey's deputy minister of education issued a post on social media telling PM Netanyahu, 'You will die'. The Pakistani Army chief threatened Israel saying, 'If Israel launches a ground attack on Gaza, Pakistan will provide ballistic missiles to the Palestinians'.

Clearly all this rhetoric needs backtracking. Instead of blindly supporting an Israel offensive described as 'defending itself' (Rishi Sunak) politicians need to start urging peace talks to stop the needless deaths of thousands of civilians on both sides.

One also needs to keep in mind the Albert Pike letter of 1871 stating that there would be three world wars, the third being a war initially between Judaism and Islam.

Incredible devastation

As I write thousands upon thousands of innocent (mostly children) are being bombed into eternity by Israeli missile strikes of various sorts. Entire suburbs are being reduced to rubble. How can this possibly be excused as Israel defending itself? This is planned genocide.

Look at videos of the widespread destruction. Whole suburbs are now rubble. Nothing like this has been seen in a European democratic nation since WWII. It is the worst ethnic cleansing and civilian annihilation in living memory – and Western leaders support it. 2.3 million civilians are trapped between the sea and a fence with nowhere to flee from the continual rain of missile strikes – missiles provided by the West.

Despite the political leaders of the West supporting Israel, all over the world huge numbers of demonstrations containing hundreds of thousands of people marched in support of the Palestinian people. This was not just Muslims but people from every religious community protesting that civilians were being collectively punished for Hamas terrorist attacks (which were allowed by Israel).

Western media now says that a ten thousand Palestinians are dead but over 200,000, possibly 300,000, are officially missing. These are people buried under collapsed buildings who are dead. This was before the ground offensive.

Denial of aid and safe spaces

Israel claims that aid is being let through. This is a lie; it is being denied to Gaza. On one day 17 trucks tried to get through but were stopped by border forces.

Israel told Palestinians to flee to south Gaza for protection – then it bombed south Gaza.

Hell on Earth

The conditions for Palestinians is beyond desperate. Those that survive bombing raids, artillery shells, tank fire and snipers, huddle into enclaves. One area housed 50,000 refugees that only had four toilets and no running water. As Israel cut off energy supply, patients in hospitals slowly died, such as dialysis and cancer patients.

The Al Shifa hospital

Israeli apologists like Douglas Murray claimed that Hamas had military positions in this hospital that justified attacks. This is a lie; there were no military bases here, no weapons and no military in tunnels. In fact the tunnels had been constructed by Israel in 1983.⁴⁰ These tunnels were filled with concrete by Hamas years ago.

The video released by the IDF to prove that Hamas had a base there was risible and facile. Its purported evidence was a rack of CDs (used to give patients details of an MMR scan), a rucksack (they called a military 'go-bag'), and neatly planted rows of minor items, including one knife and one AK47, which they later moved to a different location because the plant was obvious. This clear set up was both shameful and stupid. It made the IDF a laughing stock.

But the war crimes were hard to cover up. Apart from the bombing, four patients and two nurses were killed by Israeli troops. Snipers kept everybody inside the hospital where there was no power, no food and no water. Babies in incubators died. One person that tried to save the babies was shot and killed. Patients requiring electricity died. Many hundreds of bodies lay in the open air around the hospital. Those that tried to flee were shot on sight.⁴¹

West Bank attacks

There were also bombing runs and burning down houses on the West Bank. IDF snipers killed 90 civilians in the West Bank by 1 November 2023. By 16 November over 130 Palestinians had been killed including over 40 children. Homes are being destroyed or stolen; crops are being burned. Israeli soldiers have been filmed breaking the arms of prisoners.

Yet this is a war against Hamas, but Hamas is not present in the West Bank. This proves that this Israeli operation is a genocide to destroy all Palestinians and steal their land.

Israel celebrates

Meanwhile Israel is celebrating. Film of events in Tel Aviv show parties in the streets, people dancing and having fun, celebrating. There is no fear of warfare, despite Israeli claims to the contrary.

Multiple videos emerged of Israelis celebrating the deaths of Palestinians while calling for their complete extermination. A women pop singer was filmed singing to soldiers urging

genocide. Another woman published a video stating that images of burned and mutilated Palestinian children made her heart glow and be happy.⁴³

The justification in the West

As in previous cases, the West is currently justifying Israeli terrorism by claiming self-defence. This is preposterous for these reasons:

- Any attack by Hamas on Israeli property or persons justifies a retaliatory response against Hamas.
- There is no justification for attacks on Palestinians civilians, hospitals, schools, residential buildings etc. This is a collective punishment of innocents. Not all Palestinians even support Hamas. A tiny percentage of people are alive that voted for Hamas. Remember that half of the Palestinian people are children.
- Israeli responses must be balanced. Terrorist attacks against groups of individuals does not justify air strikes demolishing entire neighbourhoods of innocent people, mostly children.
- Hamas is actually financed by Israel as a scapegoat to provoke sympathy for Israel and justify Israeli military action. The purpose is ultimately to ethnically cleanse the area of Palestinians and demolish the entire Gaza Strip to make way for rebuilding the area as part of Israel.
- It is now clear from testimonies and video footage that the Hamas attack was an Israeli false flag. All the civilian deaths were caused by the IDF.

Israeli attitude

There is no symmetry; the children in the Gaza Strip have brought this [devastating missile strikes] upon themselves.

Israel's difficulties

Not everything went Israel's way.

The infamous Iron Dome defence system proved to be faulty and incapable of dealing with multiple missiles. Only a small proportion was stopped. Also Israel missiles malfunctioned and fell on Israeli land. A video shows one Israeli missile falling on Tel Aviv.⁴⁴

Palestinian militias also made some significant attacks, destroying tanks with close range RPGs. This was unexpected.

A further issue

It is alleged that a chief purpose in exterminating the Palestinians and annexing Gaza is to make way for the Ben Gurion canal that will cut across Israel to the Red Sea connecting to the Mediterranean Sea in northern Gaza. This would be a major global transport link. It would be wide enough for two lanes, unlike the Suez Canal, This would provide huge revenues and enable an important Western military transport facility in a friendly country. In addition large reserves of oil and gas have been discovered in Gaza.

The main area being bombed in Gaza, which will be followed by bulldozers, is the northern area where this canal will be constructed.

Conclusion

This war demonstrates the true character of Israel without any doubt. It is a warmongering, ruthless, brutal pariah state. The attack on Gaza is nothing but genocide plain and simple. The many atrocities show the cruelty of the IDF. The rejoicing of ordinary Israelis over the deaths of children and babies shows the corruption of morals created by submission to the evil Talmud, which calls non-Jews 'cattle' and allows Jews to kill Gentiles.

Fatah

Fatah was formerly the Palestinian National Liberation Movement, a nationalist and social democrat party. It is the largest faction in the multi-party PLO and the second largest faction in the Palestinian Legislative Council. The chairman is Mahmoud Abbas. Its founder was Yasser Arafat.

In 2008 Hamas took control of the Gaza Strip splintering the Palestinian Authority. Fatah controlled the Palestinian National Authority in the West Bank. Both Fatah and Hamas claim to represent the Palestinian people.

Palestinian terrorism

Israeli deception

The slogan of the Mossad (Israeli Intelligence Services) is, 'By deception – conquer' (or make war). Israel has utilised deception for decades, such as in false flag operations. It seeks to pretend that Israel is democratic, tolerant, civilised, peaceful, and righteous while its enemies are barbarian, brutal, fiendish ghouls. This is a massive deception. In reality Israel is an undemocratic, criminal, occult, apartheid system where crime (including paedophilia, sex trafficking, drug trafficking and organ trafficking) flourishes. It has one of the highest Gay populations in the world. Apologists claim that the Talmud identifies 8 separate genders.

This means that official Israeli government data on terrorist attacks against it are suspect in their intensity. It suits Israel to emphasise terrorism against its citizens to enable further persecution of Palestinians. Jewish-owned Western media then highlight terrorist attacks against Israel to justify Western support of the government. Atrocities by the IDF or missile attacks are continually ignored in the West. There is no unbiased reporting on Israel by any Western media, apart from the alternative truth channels.

An unequal match

The reality is that Israel is highly developed in military and defensive resources, constantly re-supplied by Western powers. It receives about \$3 billion a year from America (for military and economic purposes), plus fighter warplanes, naval vessels, missile systems, munitions and arms. It has missile defence systems, such as the Iron Dome, costing \$10 billion. Israel received more than \$260 billion (some say over \$300 billion) since WWII.

The Palestinians, while receiving some aid from Arab nations and Iran just does not have the infrastructure to build, house or utilise a modern offensive system. Getting resources to Gaza is very difficult. Its attacks on Israel chiefly utilise simple rocket configurations, not the more destructive missile systems available to Israel.

Thus terrorist attacks on Israel are chiefly untargeted crude rocket deployment or individual attacks, such as suicide bombers. The scale of these attacks cannot be verified independently. Also many allege that some attacks are actually false flags conducted by Israel.

Palestinian attacks usually kill a few civilians; many fail completely. Israeli response assaults (bombs, air-strikes, artillery) kill many thousands. Listing Palestinian attacks is difficult because they are so minor; very few Israelis are killed.

Some key attacks are as follows:

- **1990s**: Hamas deployed suicide bombings, notably in 1996, with 'many' Israelis killed.
- 2008: response to Operation Cast Lead. 'Hamas and others in Gaza again resorted to firing crude, homemade and mainly inaccurate rockets into Israel. During the past seven years, these rockets have been responsible for the deaths of 17 Israelis. Over the same time span, Israel Blitzkrieg assaults have killed thousands of Palestinians, drawing worldwide protest but falling on deaf ears at the UN.'45
- **2022**: 5,000 terrorist attacks were claimed against Israel (this figure was later greatly downgraded). These included car-ramming, shootings, stabbings, and bombings.⁴⁶ Few were killed.

Intifada

The word originally referred to the Palestinian uprising against Israeli occupation of the West Bank and Gaza Strip, beginning in 1987.

The word derives from the Arabic $intifa\underline{d}a$ 'an uprising' (literally 'a jumping up as a reaction to something'), from $intifa\underline{d}a$ 'be shaken, shake oneself'. From this it came to mean any new organised Palestinian uprising against Israel.

Intifada in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict:

- **1987-1993**: First Intifada.
- Late 2000 to 2005: Second (Al-Aqsa) Intifada.
- **2014**: Jerusalem Unrest; violent acts in Jerusalem.
- **2015-2016**: Al Quds Intifada.
- 2023: Hamas-Israel War.

Israeli peace initiatives

Some Israeli leaders appear to have genuinely attempted to strive for peace, such as Shimon Peres or Yizhak Rabin e.g. the Israel-Jordan peace treaty (1994). That these were unpopular with most Israeli's is evidenced in the assassination of Rabin in 1995. [He was killed by Yigal Amir who opposed the Oslo Accord.]

No Israeli-Palestinian peace negotiation has reached any conclusive settlement. This was usually the result of Israeli belligerence, such as refusing to deal with Hamas (even though they created and fund it).

- 1949: Armistice Agreements.
- 1967-80: Allon Plan.
- 1969: Roger's Plan.
- 1973: Geneva Conference.
- 1978: Camp David Accords.
- 1979: Egypt-Israel peace treaty.
- 1991: Madrid Conference.
- 1994: Israel-Jordan peace treaty.

Key recent attempts with Israeli participation

- 1993: the Oslo Accord; establishment of interim Palestinian government in Gaza and the West Bank.
- 2000: Camp David Summit negotiations between Israel and Yasser Arafat. No results.
- 2007-8: 36 meetings between Israeli PM Ehud Olmert and President Mahmoud Abbas (Palestinian Authority). No result.
- 2008: Israel-Hamas cease-fire brokered by Egypt.
- 2010: Two-state proposal resurrected from the 1980s. Israel refused to negotiate with Hamas and Hezbollah.
- 2013-14: Peace talks following an American initiative. Israel refused to deal with Hamas being involved. Israel initiated sanctions against Palestinians and cancelled housing plans. Nothing resulted except that a new unified Palestinian government was established, the Palestinian Unity Government.

However, more recent Israeli history is dominated by Netanyahu who is a severe hawk committed to the genocide of the Palestinians and the full occupation of the whole land by Israel. There is no hope for any peace agreement under his leadership.

Most Israelis have no confidence in peace negotiations or a two-state system. The creation of Hamas (q.v.) added to this insecurity and denial of a peaceful settlement.

The Yinon Plan

In short, the Yinon Plan aims to Balkanise (partition) neighbouring states, such as Syria or Iraq, and then annex key areas of several nations to create 'Greater Israel'. In this way it intends to dominate the whole Middle East. Nations affected by this plan include: Syria, Iraq, Yemen, Libya, Lebanon, Jordan and others.

The foreign policy of America in the last 20 years (Project for a New American Century / Rebuilding America's Defences) has been to facilitate this plan for Greater Israel. Thus the Iraq war, based upon fabrications, was part of this plan. The destabilisation of Syria and support for a fundamentalist (Salafist) Islamic revolution in Syria was part of this plan. The annexation of northern Syria by US military bases and US-supported Islamic (ISIS, al Nusra) towns is completely illegal but is facilitating this plan.

The plan also involves the complete annexation of all remaining Palestinian territory as part of the 'New Middle East', a map presented to the UN by Netanyahu recently which showed the elimination of all Palestinian land.

Observation of modern Israel's history

Palestine was relatively peaceful until the creation of Zionism. Since the 1930s, and especially after 1948, there has been nothing but violence, terrorism, war, destruction and mayhem by Zionists / Israel to other people. This is a plain historical fact. There are individual incidents almost daily where Palestinians are shot or brutalised for trivial incidents (such as walking too near the fence). Often children are shot. Pregnant women have been shot deliberately in the belly.

On top of that is the brutal persecution of Palestinians in the Gaza Strip and the theft of houses and land in West Bank settlements.

Why the West paints a rosy picture of Israel

The Western media and political class continually favours Israel in reporting. Palestinians are labelled as terrorists and Israeli war crimes are dismissed as 'self-defence'. The reasons for this are as follows:

- The mainstream media is completely owned by Jews or Jewish supporters. Most of the press and news media is owned by a small number of Jewish interests.
- Western politicians are dominated by Jewish interests and lobby groups. In America, Congressmen are required to sign an oath of allegiance to Israel but not to America. Those that refuse get their political careers ended; usually by lack of funding for reelection.
- Politicians and media ensure that serious criticism of Israel is deleted and censored.
- The 'Anti-Semitic' accusation is used indiscriminately against critics of Israel whether there is any justification or not. This usually enough to shut critics down and cause fear to speak. Israel has openly boasted that this is a useful trick to shut down opposition.

As a result, the West receives a single message regarding any issues involving Israel.

Attitude of Jews towards Gentiles

How can Israelis commit genocide against the Palestinians? How can they deliberately break both arms of a young teenager? How can they shoot a pregnant woman in the belly? How could they cut out the baby of a pregnant woman with a knife? How could they shoot six-year old children playing football? The answer is that they do not consider non-Jews to be humans at all. They call them dogs or cattle. This is the teaching of their prime authority the Talmud. It is often repeated by Jews in authority.

The 'trick' of Anti-Semitism claims

You can find multiple Jewish testimonies pointing out that the charge of anti-Semitism against critics of Israel is a trick used to shut down opposition. This is a very convenient tool to stifle debate with an ad hominem attack.

In some countries, such as Germany, being charged with anti-Semitism can lead to you being imprisoned; even if what you said was true. One aged, eminent, German historian professor (Ms Ursula Haverbeck) was jailed on anti-Semitism charges for merely asking the government valid questions about the sites of Holocaust gas chambers (clue: no one could identify any).

This 'trick' is not valid for these reasons:

- Every opinion and action should be able to be subjected to analysis and criticism without favour.
- No other ethnic group has this privilege of protected status; why should Jews?
- It is used only for attacks on Jews but not on Arabs, who are Semites⁴⁷ and Abrahamic (through Ishmael). When Arabs criticise Jews they are called anti-Semitic.
- The vast majority of Jews are not Semitic. Ashkenazi Jews (Russian Jews) stem from the Khazars who adopted Judaism en masse before they were conquered by the Varangian Rus and dispersed throughout Europe. [The minority Sephardic Jews (Spanish Jews) mostly stem from Idumeans. These adopted Judaism en masse but descended from Edomites, who were from Esau, Abraham's cursed son. Other Jewish factions (e.g. Mizrahi Jews, Karaites, and Ethiopian Jews; there are many more) occupy a very small percentage of Jewry.]
- In Israel the Sephardim are persecuted by Ashkenazis, along with Christian Arabs and Muslim Arabs. This is the ruling non-Semitic faction of Jews persecuting Semites.
- Most Palestinians are Semitic because they are Arabs, whether Christian or Muslim.

Ethnicitu

One needs to keep in mind that Judaism is a religious status, not an ethnic one. Jews are not a race but a religious group. That is why there are Italian Jews, Greek Jews, Ethiopian Jews, American Jews, Spanish Jews etc. Therefore, criticising Jews cannot be racist.

The idea that a Jew is someone purely descended from Abraham via Isaac and Jacob is a myth. Israelites in the OT were such but modern Jews have little connection to these. The various national Jews (e.g. Ethiopian Jews) are proselytes with no ethnic connection to Abraham. Ashkenazi Jews are not even Semitic. Most Sephardim are Semitic but not descended from Jacob. Some Sephardim that migrated early to Spain (before 70 AD) may be descended from Jacob but it is doubtful that they retained racial purity.

The truth is that despite claims otherwise, Jews continually inter-married with Gentiles in order to prosper. DNA tests have demonstrated this time after time. For example people named Cohen, who thought they were descended from OT Israelites, had Azerbaijani and European DNA.

Often Jews not only intermarried but changed their name in order to fit in with Gentile society (something forbidden to real Jews). Thus many American Jews named 'Cohen' (i.e. *kohen*, a priest) changed their name to Cowan, which is a Scottish name.

Within Jewry there is not just the divisions of historical background but also of religious practice. There is no uniformity. Thus we have:

- Talmudic Jews (applies to most Ashkenazis).
- Tanakh⁴⁸ Jews (Karaites).
- Torah Jews (opposed to Zionism and Talmudism, i.e. rabbinical Judaism).
- Liberal Jews (religious but in a very lax way).
- Orthodox Jews.
- Atheistic Jews.
- Secular Jews.
- Crypto-Jews (Jews pretending to be Catholic or otherwise but doing so falsely).

The stated goal of Israel

In fact, compared to our race, other races are beasts and animals, cattle at best. Other races are considered as human excrement, Our destiny is to rule over the inferior races. Conclusion

An assessment of this history leads to these conclusions.

- Many ethnic groups controlled Palestine for decades, centuries and millennia.
- Hebrews only controlled Palestine in total for the period (40 years) under King David [reigned c.1000-c.962 BC] and then King Solomon (reigned 40 years). Control before and after was patchy.
- There was significant (not complete) control under Joshua but far less under the Judges. Numerous kingdoms and empires had sovereignty over the land with Israelites paying tribute and allegiance, e.g. Egypt, Moabites, Midianites, Ammonites, Philistines, Canaanites, Edomites etc.
- After David the United Kingdom did not outlive Solomon. The Northern Kingdom (Israel) was lost to the Assyrians in 721 BC. The Southern Kingdom (Judah) fell to the Babylonians in 586 BC.
- After this the land was controlled by the Achaemenids (under which some Israelites returned from Babylon), the Greeks and then the Romans (with a short period of Hebrew control under the Hasmonaeans).
- The land was then controlled by Muslim caliphates from 634 to 1918 (with a short interlude in the Crusades).
- Therefore Jews have less claim to the land than many others.
- Modern Ashkenazi Jews (the majority), e.g. Netanyahu, are not even Semites and have no claim to the land whatsoever.
- The Bible affirms that Jews are no longer God's people, the kingdom has been given to Gentiles, and Jews are under severe judgment of God for rejecting their Messiah.
- Zionism is a political movement that gained supremacy in the 20th century based on false principles. It managed to coerce Western nations into supporting the claims of Israel to Palestine.
- The UN enabled Jews to steal a part of Palestine for a Jewish homeland in 1948.
- Immediately, Jews initiated a war with the Palestinians resulting in massacres and ethnic cleansing. Huge areas of Palestinian land were stolen.
- The West, chiefly the USA, supported Israel with aid, economic and military packages. The US gave Israel over \$260 billion since 1948. Israel also gained nuclear technology by espionage (Jewish spies in America) but ensures that its neighbours do not get this technology.
- Further wars and terrorist actions over decades resulted in more stolen land. Palestinians were largely centred in the West Bank and the Gaza Strip. Entire Jewish settlements have been erected on stolen Palestinian land. Houses and fields are routinely stolen.
- Israel has terrorised Gaza, which has been an open-air concentration camp for 16 years. Food, water and essential items are either rationed or denied innocent Palestinians. Israel has continually bombed and struck Gaza with missiles. Individuals are killed without mercy for trivial offences (such as playing football near the fence, or demonstrating).
- Palestinian 'terrorist' organisations have arisen to stand against Israel for the terrorising of Palestinian people; e.g. the PLO, Hamas, Hezbollah.
- Israel is an apartheid terrorist state far worse than Afrikaans South Africa ever was.
- Israel also started wars with neighbouring nations, such as Lebanon and continually deploys illegal air strikes against Syria and other places.
- Israel's stated aim is to control the whole Middle East occupying large parts of surrounding nations in 'Greater Israel'.

The support of the West for Israel is dominated by huge propaganda exercises perpetrated by Jewish interests that control western media, commerce, banking, trade, NGOs and politics. This ensures that populations are conditioned to support Israel even when they commit war crimes and atrocities. Any dissent against Israel is shut down as anti-Semitism, even though the leaders of Israel are not even Semitic. Therefore supporting Palestinian victims of Israeli atrocities is anti-Semitic even though the Palestinian Arabs are themselves Semitic but the Jews are not.

The support of modern Christians for Israel was secured by the corruption of dogmatics, especially the introduction of Dispensationalism which led to supporting Zionism (it was funded by Zionists and promoted by a criminal). These people have been deceived to think that modern Jews are God's people through not studying the Bible properly. They then support Israel atrocities against Palestinians even though a large proportion of these are actually Christian. The Devil is laughing out loud. 'Peasant'; a farmer or agricultural worker. Derives from Arabic for ploughman or tiller.

Galut

Hebrew for 'exile'. The Diaspora of Jews in the world.

Hamas

Acronym of 'The Islamic Resistance Movement'. Political and militant movement opposed to Israel based in Gaza.

IDF

Israel Defence Force. Mostly made up of reservists who serve for two or more years.

Hezbollah

'Party of God'. Shia terrorist and political movement opposed to Israel centred in Lebanon but also present in the West Bank.

Intifada

'Terror', shuddering'. An uprising wave of attacks by Palestinians against Israel.

Knesset

The Israeli parliament (literally 'gathering').

Likud Party

A coalition of right-wing Israeli political parties, formed in 1973. Likud returned to power in 1996 under Benjamin Netanyahu. Origin: Hebrew, literally 'consolidation, unity'.

Mossad

'Ha-Mossad le-Modin u-le-Tafkidim Meyuhadim'; the Israeli Intelligence Services.

Nakba

'Catastrophe'; a state of emergency referring to the suffering of the Palestinians around 1948. The current Israeli-Hamas war is being called the 'new Nakba'.

Yishuv

The body of Jewish residents in Palestine prior to the establishment of the State of Israel in 1948.
