

The alleged moon landings

There are many questionable features about this, but here I want to demonstrate some confirmed, mathematical, scientific facts that question the official NASA narrative.

The temperature on the moon's surface is 107 degrees Celsius; that is above the boiling point of water. This means that multiple claimed events could not have occurred; e.g.

- The photograph left on the moon's surface by Charlie Duke, that was supposedly filmed by NASA, would have immediately curled up; it did not.
- The Lunar Rover would not have been able to function since the temperature was way above the tolerances for the parts, and especially the battery (heat tolerance of 52°C) - according to NASA's own documentation [*Lunar Roving Vehicle Operating Handbook*].
- How did the astronauts cope with the heated up Lunar Module which was up to eight hours on the moon at 107°C (there is no convection on the moon)? They couldn't.

The Lunar Rover's dimensions prove that it would not have been able to be transported in the Lunar Command Module, even if the wheels were folded up. Also tracks of the vehicle in photos are in the wrong place; some NASA photos show no tracks.

There is clear evidence of photographic anomalies proving that a photographed backdrop was used in multiple cases (like a movie stage). Scientists have proved that some NASA photos of the moon landings (such as Apollo 17) definitely have screen background projection techniques used in the landscape photos.

The supposed 2009 NASA telescope [*Lunar Reconnaissance Orbiter*] photographs of apparatus [e.g. the LEM] left behind on the moon's surface are false because they are the wrong size (four times too large). The images are also of poorer quality than current GeoEye satellite pictures of earth.

NASA photos of well-defined footprints would have required moisture to get such defined impressions. There is no moisture on the moon at 107°C.

The Soviet Union never went to the moon because they said that it was impossible. Remember that the USSR was ahead of the US in space technology and put the first satellite, the first dog and the first man into space. The US still uses Russian rockets.

The NAZI rocket scientist who led the US space technological development after the war (Wernher von Braun) said in 1953 that getting to the moon was impossible by rocket propulsion because no ship could carry sufficient fuel. He did all the calculations.

NASA employees that publicly stated that the Apollo programme would never work (e.g. astronaut Gus Grissom) were assassinated.
