The false Ukraine narrative

How the West continually spews utter lies regarding the Russian -Ukrainian conflict: a simple summary

Introduction

In various papers I have explained what is really going on in Ukraine, what the background is and what the purpose of NATO is.¹ In this paper I wish to gather together the whole picture in as simple a manner as possible to counter the continual lying reports in the mainstream media. Frequently these reports are the very opposite of the truth.

This situation is not about favouring one or another party but of establishing the truth. It is necessary to do this to avoid manipulation by wicked governments. Do not be cajoled by the media to believe a pack of lies and be herded into following globalist plans.

Potted background history

Ukraine political history

- **9**th **century**: The Ukraine has been part of Russia since the 9th century, with some areas controlled by other powers for some periods. The Kievan Rus forms the beginning of formal Varangian² historical records.
- **13th century**: Mongol conquest (the Golden Horde).
- Late 14th century: Following the collapse of Mongol rule, the principality of Muscovy emerged as the pre-eminent state. Gradually it absorbed formerly independent principalities, such as Novgorod (1478), forming a centralised Russian state.
- **17th century**: Kiev was successively held by Lithuania and Poland until the Cossack revolt of 1648 when it briefly became the capital of a Ukrainian state. It returned to Russian control in 1654.
- After the Russo-Polish War of 1654-67 the eastern part of Ukraine (east of the Dnieper River) came under Russian rule.
- **18th century**: After the Partitions of Poland in 1772, 1793 and 1795, the extreme west of Ukraine fell under the control of the Austro-Hungarian Empire until 1895. The east was part of the Russian Empire.
- In 1783, after the Russo-Turkish War (1768-74) Russia defeated the Khanate³ and Crimea came under Russian control, a situation which lasted until the break-up of the Soviet Union in 1991.
- **20th century**: Ukraine was not a unified country until 1922 as part of the Soviet Union but was an area of various states under different hegemonies (Cossacks, Poland, Lithuania, the Austro-Hungarian Empire, Russia, Mongols etc.).
- Before the Soviet Union was constituted the Ukraine was made up of different territories held by various interests but there was always a difference between the east,

which was dominated by Russian-speaking people, and the west, which looked more towards Europe. The west was a part of the Austria-Hungarian Empire for a long time. Many in the west are of Polish / Lithuanian extraction but there are also many subgroups: Tartars, Mongols, Hungarians, Greeks etc.

- The Ukraine did not really exist as an independent state until Lenin consolidated it whereupon Kiev became the capital of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic in 1934.
- Territorial gains from Romania, eastern Poland, and Slovakia completed the union of all Ukrainian lands into one republic by 1945, the Crimea being added in 1954.
- Khruschev relinquished the Ukraine in 1954.
- The Communist Party of the Soviet Union maintained firm control over the federation until the late 1980s, when pressures developed for greater independence.
- In 1991 the Soviet Union disintegrated. Russia became an independent state but led a new body, the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) which most of the former Soviet republics joined.
- The Ukraine Supreme Soviet formally declared independence in August 1991, with overwhelming support in a referendum.
- Relations with Russia became problematic. Russia lost a key buffer state against the west. However, the Ukrainians voted in pro-Russian governments as their allegiance is historically with Russia and not the west.
- Following independence, the largely Russian region of the Crimea declared itself an autonomous region in 1992.
- Ukraine formally joined the Commonwealth of Independent States in 1993. It is not technically an independent state.
- The Crimean Peninsula (majority Russian) was reorganised as the Republic of Crimea. A 1991 referendum pushed for more independence from Ukraine and closer ties with Russia.
- 1995: Ukraine abolished the Crimean Republic by force. A 1997 treaty established the Russian fleet in a partitioned area in Sevastopol.
- **21st century**: 2014: Crimea had a referendum and 96% elected to join with Russia. Russia did not arbitrarily annex Crimea. Crimea became independent. A survey by the Pew Research Centre showed that the majority of Crimean residents believed that the referendum was free and fair (91%). This was rejected by the UN and the West imposed sanctions on Russia. Putin correctly stated that independence complied with the selfdetermination of peoples.
- The eastern Ukraine (Donbass region) Donetsk and Lugansk People's Republic was established in 2014. These areas effectively declared themselves independent from the Ukraine government. The American dominated Kiev regime resisted this violently.

Ukraine's recent moral history

- After independence, the country became more and more corrupt and engaged in multiple criminal enterprises. The leadership was dominated by genuine Nazis. The life of ordinary Ukrainians was very difficult, suffering hardships.
- To say that the Ukraine is a failed state is an understatement; it is more of a corrupt, criminal, genocidal territory that functions as a pupper US state.
- Ukraine is a centre for all sorts of criminal activity on behalf of the deep state: moneylaundering, organ trafficking, drug running, biological weapons storage, weapons trafficking and so on.
- Global Elite leaders, allegedly including Joe Biden and Hunter Biden, Obama and many others, have vested interests in the criminal enterprises conducted in Ukraine. This is one reason why the West is trying to protect those interests and prevent exposure.
- Zionist Nazis and Zionist Mafia have effectively run day to day operations since 2014.

- The former Jewish oligarch banker Poroshenko, who was put in power by the CIA in 2014 and served until 2019, is now being prosecuted for multiple crimes. Poroshenko also, contrary to diplomatic agreements, sought closer ties with the west initiating integration with the EU by signing the Ukraine-European Union Association Agreement. He also posed with a soldier wearing SS Tottenkopf insignia.
- The Ukrainian Nazis are far-right radical nationalists that dominate the puppet government. They idolise a Nazi called Stepan Bandera,⁴ and commemorate his birthday, a man who fought with German Nazis in WWII. They have put up monuments to people that fought with an SS Panzer division that massacred an entire village in France. They openly wear SS insignia on their uniforms. This is not just the Azov Battalion⁵ but other units as well, such as the C-14 youth group.
- The Ukraine government hates the Russian speaking people in the Donbass whom it calls 'untermensch' (sub-human; lit. 'underman'). This is actually a Nazi term for non-Aryan inferior people including eastern Slavs.
- The Ukraine people are as decent as any other nation; the problem is the corrupt government.

The military action against the Donbass

- After the 2014 coup [see later], Ukraine (under NATO influence) began military actions against the Eastern Ukraine Russians in the area known as the Donbass. This was unprovoked and based upon a hatred for Russians by NATO and minority Nazi factions that had a powerful interest in Ukraine.
- Jerusalem sent military equipment, officers and settlers from Israel to Ukraine, along with troops, equipment and construction of new bases, fully supported by the US. IDF forces led militias in support of the Ukraine government.
- The subsequent violence that killed over 14,000 civilians in the next eight years did not originate from Russian rebels but came from the puppet Zionist Ukrainian forces, despite the constant stream of lies from the media that Russia instigated the violence.
- Finally, the Ukrainian army refused to go into East Ukraine and fight their own people (Russian speaking Ukrainians), forcing the puppet government to ask for NATO and US troops to stop the popular resistance to Zionist plans.
- The Donbass Russian-speaking area has been constantly shelled for eight years by the CIA proxy Ukrainian government using Nazi battalions. The suffering of the Russian people has been intense and long-lasting. Shelling occurred every single day killing men, women and children. Some children lived constantly in basements for the first eight years of their life.
- There is also a food blockade.
- There have been defensive retaliatory actions but these were small in comparison with the resources and support of the American military for the Ukrainian military, which included strike drones.
- In the last eight years at least 14,000 people have been killed in the Donbass conflict. An OSCE monitoring mission noted 2,000 cease-fire violations by Kiev with many violations of humanitarian laws. In one case 48 civilians were herded into a union trade-house precinct and burned alive.
- Before the Russian action, Ukraine troops were massing on the line of contact with 60,000 soldiers gathered ready for a big push to slaughter Russian-speaking citizens. This is why Putin was forced to act. It was not an invasion but a liberation.

• The US has sought, by manipulating the media, to keep the atrocities of the Ukraine government a secret. Most people have no clue.

The referendums⁶

- In 2022 the chief provinces in the Donbass staged a referendum on whether to stay in Ukraine or join the Russian federation.
- The provinces overwhelmingly elected to join Russia, whom they have naturally sided with for centuries. No surprise there.
- The referendums were observed by witnesses from many European and other nations. More than thirty observers were at each site. These witnesses stated that the plebiscite was fair and legal.
- Despite this, Western media claimed that the referendums were illegal and tainted despite sending no correspondents to witness any of it.

Lie: NATO is no threat to Russia

This lie is still being spouted by ignorant hacks, even on decent websites.⁷ The truth has been articulated by Prof. John Mearsheimer⁸, Major Scott Ritter, Col Douglas MacGregor and Peter Hitchens.⁹ The facts are undeniable; NATO is a clear and present threat on Russia's doorstep. The facts are so stark that only a fool could think otherwise.

- NATO was formed as a Cold War defensive deterrent to a burgeoning Soviet Union. After the collapse of the USSR, NATO should have been disbanded. Instead, it expanded in size, finances and occupied many more countries with military bases. It became the global Elite armed services.
- There was a diplomatic agreement between the US and Gorbachev that NATO would not advance Eastwards, 'even one inch'. This agreement secured the Soviet withdrawal from East Germany to allow for reunification. This provided Russia with a buffer zone separating it from the EU and NATO influence in Eastern Europe. Diplomatic assurances were given to Russia on several occasions, such as by US Secretary of State James Baker. No treaty was signed but diplomacy secured peace; however, the agreement was put into writing in the form of letters
- Contrary to diplomatic agreements, NATO expanded into Poland, Romania, Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, establishing US military bases. Poland (1999), Latvia (2004), Lithuania (2004) and Estonia (2004) became members of NATO. Ukraine became a de-facto member of NATO from 2014. Russia did not advance westwards.
- In addition NATO established military bases stretching from Finland to Turkey, the Gulf States, and also down to Northern Australia. It is currently planning to put more military bases in South East Asia.
- On top of this America established 12 bioweapons level-4 laboratories in Ukraine financed by the US Dept. of Defence. Some biologically-weaponised insects have already escaped causing disease in Georgia. These also pose a major threat to Russia.
- Ukraine sought formal NATO and EU membership posing an existential threat to Russia.

- Before the current Russian conflict, America spent billions arming and training Ukrainian troops for years. This has been done blatantly with no embarrassment. Special forces like the SAS were training Ukrainian soldiers. NATO countries have also sent in troops under the pretext of exercises. In 2021 over 23,000 troops and more than 1,000 units of hardware were involved in military operations in the Ukraine. Ukrainian soldiers are already integrated into NATO. NATO can thus issue direct commands down to the level of squads.
- Ukrainian airspace was open to flights by US strategic and reconnaissance aircraft and drones that conduct surveillance over Russia. The US built Maritime Operations Centre in Ochakov is able to support NATO warships against the Russian Black Sea fleet and coast.
- Effectively, the Ukraine is now a de-facto NATO country contrary to international treaties. This posed a severe threat to Russia. Russia had a hostile international army on its border in a country that was shelling Russian people. Putin said that NATO's military infrastructure is, 'a knife to our throat'. This is western aggression of the first order.
- In addition, interceptor missiles are being established in Romania and Poland as part of a US project to create a global missile defence system. Launchers deployed can be used for Tomahawk cruise missiles to attack Russia. American strategic planning documents confirm the possibility of a pre-emptive strike. US ballistic missiles can penetrate over 5,000 km into Russia. The flying time of a Tomahawk missile aimed at Moscow is less than 35 minutes. Ballistic missiles from Kharkov will take 8 minutes. Hypersonic weapons only four minutes.
- Russia wants NATO to withdraw to its pre-1997 borders in the East.

Lie: Russia started this war

The truth

Ukraine started this conflict under the influence of the US and NATO by persecuting and shelling the Donbass. Putin did not declare war on Ukraine but sought to liberate Russians facing genocide in the east. The purpose of NATO ramping up the military conflict into a proxy war was to weaken the Russia, destabilise and dishearten the Russian people and force regime change. The aim is to defeat Russia and then Balkanise it into controllable smaller states (like Yugoslavia).

The 2014 coup and consequences

- The conflict started in 2014 and it was provoked by the Ukraine government under the influence of the USA.
- The US, chiefly led by Victoria Nuland (who hates Russia) and the CIA, arranged the toppling of the Russian-friendly premier, Vildor Yanukovych, in a violent coup. Yanukovych's election had been certified by the Organisation for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE). The mainstream media misrepresents what happened, blaming Yanukovych; but this was a typical CIA regime change operation.
- A pro-West puppet regime was put in place. The new puppet regime passed anti-Russian laws, which largely affected the two regions in the Donbass (eastern Ukraine). It then launched a civil war.
- This government proceeded to persecute Russian speaking Ukrainians in multiple ways: killing dissidents, cancelling and then killing Russian speaking journalists; terminating Russian media; forbidding the speaking of Russian etc. In the coup 48 Russians were set on fire outside a public building.

- The Donbass Russian-speaking area rebelled against this illegal overthrow and two regions declared their independence. These were Donetsk and Lugansk, which declared themselves a republic (the Donetsk People's Republic [DPR] and the Lugansk People's Republic [LPR]).
- The DPR and LPR in the Donbass were recognised by the UN.
- The Ukraine government began a civil war, shelling the Donbass every day, killing thousands and perpetrating atrocities.
- The Ukraine government, in its hatred of the 4 million Russian-speaking residents in the Donbass, used the services of Nazi paramilitary groups to conduct warfare on its behalf. These are armed, supplied, and trained by western governments. The bombs that fell on innocent Russian women and children were paid for by your taxes but initiated by real Nazis who are inspired by German Nazis. This is why Putin called for de-Nazification.
- Donbass has been fighting to secure their right to vote, since the majority voted for Yanukovych. The Minsk Agreements (2014 / 2015) secured the two republic's political autonomy. The UN Security Council Resolution No. 2202 (February 2015) consolidated this agreement. Ukraine, NATO and the EU ignored these agreements.
- The Ukraine then sought to have membership in NATO and secure nuclear weapons from the West.
- NATO poured in billions of dollars of weaponry and provided thousands of military advisors, including the SAS.
- Putin tried all possible diplomatic avenues to secure the safety of the Donbass people for eight years, to no avail.
- Russia, after trying all diplomatic avenues, had no choice but to intervene to stop the genocide of the Russians in the Donbass and get rid of the military threat on its doorstep.
- Putin declared that when the Donbass has been secured, with Ukraine being neutral, demilitarised and de-Nazified, he will withdraw. He is not on an imperialistic mission.
- After a rapid successful military campaign in two days, Putin offered peace negotiations. The Ukraine government rejected this. Loss of life since 25 February is due to Zelensky, or rather the global elite controlling him.

Anti-Russian actions

- The Ukrainian government outlawed Russian opposition political parties thus ending voting rights for Russian people.
- It got rid of Russian-speaking television productions. Four opposition TV channels were banned
- Speaking in Russian was forbidden.
- It then cut off food supplies and electricity in an embargo.
- It cut of fresh water supplies to the Crimea by damming the Dnieper canal.
- Many journalists were murdered while others were imprisoned. Censorship prevailed.
- Dissidents were imprisoned or murdered.
- Ethnic minorities (e.g. the Hungarian minority) were persecuted and discriminated against and not allowed to speak their language.

The planned genocide

After eight years of shelling and missile strikes into the Donbass, the Ukrainian government planned complete genocide of the Russians in the east. Nazis even boasted about killing all the children to terminate the blood lines. 60,000 troops mobilised on the Donbass border for military action in March 2022.

This is what caused Putin to order a liberating force in February to protect Russians in the Donbass and de-militarise Ukraine for the security of Russian people.

Lie: Russia illegally annexed Crimea

Background

- The Ukraine, especially Eastern Ukraine and the Crimea, have historically been associated with Russia for centuries.
- Its capital city is Kiev, the original centre of the modern Russian people (The Kievan Rus¹⁰).
- In 1954 the Zionist dominated Soviets gave Crimea to the Ukraine to weaken Russia geo-politically. The Elite does not want Russia to dominate the Bosphorus.¹¹ The Russian people were given no vote in this. This followed giving Eastern Ukraine to Ukraine. This was to be used later as a strategic tool to destroy Russia when it was no longer needed.
- The people in the autonomous republic of Crimea within the Ukraine are 90+% Russian and this is where the Russian navy is based.
- Crimea declared itself an autonomous region in 1992.
- Since 2014 sovereignty over the Crimea has been affirmed by Russia after pro-Russian separatists occupied the region.

The coup and aftermath

- From late 2013, Zionists began the subversion of Ukraine from within with US assistance (a Gladio B operation).
- This was because President Viktor Yanukovych turned from closer ties with the EU and sought closer connections with Russia.
- By creating internal chaos and violent revolution and civil unrest (as they did in Libya, Tunisia, Egypt and Syria) the democratically elected president of Ukraine was forced to flee and the state was open.
- The Zionist puppet Petro Poroshenko was elected (7 June 2014) on an ostensibly pro-EU basis.
- Instead of siding with the legally appointed president and upholding the rule of law, the West recognised the new government in the Ukraine, which was anti-Russian and led by a Jew.
- This new government was ready to join NATO; this would then be a staging post to invade Russia, using the demand to leave the Crimea (including moving the navy).
- Instead Putin got the people of Crimea to vote in a legal referendum in support of reunification with Russia; 90% decided to stay with Russia.
- Crimea, through a legal referendum, became formally part of the Russian Federation and protected by Russian troops. Russia and six member UN states recognised Crimea as part of the Russian federation but most international bodies did not.
- With no murmur from western media, the Ukrainian puppet government cut off the Crimea from freshwater supplies after its legal separation from the Ukraine. This was 85% of Crimea's water requirements. It also cut off its electric supply. Immediately on

invading the Ukraine, Putin was able to restore the water supply by unlocking the North Crimean Canal connected to the Dnieper River.

Lie: Russia is demoralised and suffering economic hardships, Putin is sick and facing dissent

- Putin is a hugely popular leader who rescued Russia from economic collapse and rape by the West. His approval rating is always in the high 70s or 80s%.
- He is a devout Orthodox Christian and has supervised the rebuilding of thousands of churches and restoring the Russian Orthodox Church system. As Russian Orthodoxy is the majority faith in Russia, the people love Putin for his work.
- Like Assad, if you talk to Russian people on the street the vast majority not only support him but they revere him.
- All the way through the conflict the public has given overwhelming support for the military actions. They understand that the Donbass Russians were facing extermination and that something needed to be done. They also realise that Russia is fighting for its very existence as a national state facing attack by NATO and Western Elites.
- While the sanctions have done some damage and initially reduced GDP a little, the Ruble is now stronger than ever and exports are still high with other countries stepping into the breach. Trade partnerships with China, India and other countries have increased. More and more nations are turning from the US dollar and are seeking to join the BRICS nations. These include Saudi Arabia and Iran. When formalised this will collapse the US dollar hegemony. By 2023 the GDP began increasing; unlike many Western nations.
- Russian supermarket shelves are full of produce, there are no major shortages and the price of petrol is very low. Russia has huge natural resources, many untapped so far. In contrast European energy prices are through the roof and people are suffering. Britain now has empty supermarket shelves for many goods including fruit and vegetables.
- Putin is a very fit person who embraces martial art disciplines. He is an eloquent and wise statesman. He recently gave a two-hour plus articulate speech. His speeches, often without notes or prompts, show an inherent knowledge of economics, history, geopolitics and religion. In contrast, Joe Biden cannot even articulate single sentences read from a teleprompt. Sunak has no charisma and also just parrots what has been written for him on a teleprompt. Boris Johnson had a puerile charm and charisma but an appalling grasp of content and detail. Despite his faults, the only politician able to match Putin would have been Donald Trump who would also have stopped the war and made a deal.

Lie: Russia invaded Ukraine illegally and started a war that will attempt to continue into Eastern Europe

- The Russian military operation was not an invasion but was entirely in accordance with UN rules to act in order to prevent genocide against its own people.
- Putin has formally explained that the purpose of the military action was to: 1) protect the Russians in the Donbass; 2) to demilitarise Ukraine to ensure the security of the Donbass; 3) to de-nazify Ukraine (the cause of most of the hostility to the Russians).
- Russia has no plans to invade Europe; neither would it make any military or economic sense.

- Russia does not even want to destroy Ukraine. It believes that the Ukrainian people are its brothers. It is opposed to the criminal, despotic Ukrainian government under US / Zionist Neocon control.
- Russia invaded Ukraine with 190,000 troops at the most. They made no effort to conquer all of Ukraine and there is no way that they could have done so with so few troops. When Germany invaded Poland in 1939 they utilised 1.5 million troops.
- Despite this, the West has continually claimed that Putin intends to invade Eastern Europe. Poland is on a war footing, scared that Russia will attack after defeating Ukraine. 200,000 troops were mobilised to the Belarus border.
- With vastly superior military equipment and hypersonic weapons Russia could advance to Berlin and Europe would have little ability to stop this since its weapons and military are run down. But this would make no sense. The economic cost would be immense and what would be the gain? How could Russia maintain a hold on such a vast area with lengthy supply chains? The idea is stupid and Putin is not stupid.

The [current] offensive is not about taking territory. Putin does not want any more than the four oblasts and the Crimea, which can be held as part of Russia and which contain at least 60% of Ukraine's industry and natural resources. Occupying vast swathes of rural Ukraine, with a hostile population and a likely guerrilla campaign, is beyond Russian resources and beyond Russian aspirations. The offensive is about killing or disabling Ukrainian soldiers and destroying their equipment to achieve the aim of a demilitarised, de-Nazified Ukraine. ... It is thus an offensive based on attrition.

Lie: Russia has targeted civilians

- It did not target civilians at all but only military installations. It is possible that some civilians have been accidental collateral damage. In fact it hindered its own advance in order to minimise both civilian and its own troop casualties.
- After NATO escalated the conflict, Russia needed to target energy infrastructure that is a part of usual military actions. This affects civilians but the cause was the NATO escalation. Putin offered peace terms in February 2022.
- In fact Ukraine has constantly targeted civilian areas and structures for many years. It has even hit a market square in Donetsk, waiting until the rescue services and civilians rushed to give medical aid, and then sent another missile to hit the milling people.
- Ukraine forces have constantly used civilian dwellings, schools, and hospitals, as military bases using civilians as a human shield.
- Ukraine even fired missiles into Russian territory killing civilians outside the war-zone, provoking military escalation.

Lie: Russia has suffered more casualties than Ukraine

- Multiple statistics are banded about in the West claiming that Russia has lost over 200,000 troops. Wikipedia affirms that Russia has lost 200,000 dead. This is US propaganda. The high figure for Russian losses is a maximum of 50,000 according to many sane commentators. It may be much less. The Russian FSB states 29,500 killed; this could be an under-estimate. MEDUSA confirms that Russian losses are in the region of 14,000.
- Casualty figures are very hard to verify but there is a good case to be made for far higher Ukrainian deaths than Russian in spite of the reports in the western mainstream media: there is little or no sign, for example, of demonstrations by Russian families demanding to know what

has happened to their sons, whereas these are now widespread in Ukraine.' Lt General Jonathon Riley.

- Usually an attacking force suffers more casualties than the defenders. This shows the caution of Russian generals to protect troops.
- The best estimate by genuine experts (not the BBC) is that there are five (or even more; at times the figure has been eight) Ukraine casualties to every Russian casualty.
- Col Douglas MacGregor, a Pentagon expert, recently affirmed that Ukraine has lost 257,000 dead and a further 500,000 wounded casualties. Two weeks later new estimates appeared saying that the Ukraine military death toll was between 275,000 and 350,000. In several battles Ukraine lost a thousand soldiers every day. In comparison Britain now has an army consisting of 20,000 troops.
- Clearly Ukraine is short of troops (despite outnumbering the Russians) because it is: 1) conscripting old-aged pensioners; 2) conscripting jailed prisoners; 3) conscripting teenagers; 4) encouraging young girls to become troops.
- The reason for the decimation of Ukrainian troops is the hellfire of Russian tactics. This is the use of missiles, drones and heavy artillery to constantly bombard Ukrainian positions every day. Everyone sent to the front line will be killed within hours or days. Tanks and equipment sent to the front lines are obliterated within hours.
- Note the difference in tactics. Russia is seeking to protect its own troops by its military tactics. Thus it withdraws soldiers from heavy attacks in cities and avoids street to street fighting with small arms. Ukraine pushes multiple regiments into those cities, which are then destroyed by heavy Russian shellfire.

Lie: Russia is running out of weapons and munitions

- This lie has been reiterated time after time for the last 9 months by British politicians and spokesmen.
- The lie is proved by the fact that Russia has not stepped down its barrage of Ukrainian troops and equipment. In fact it has increased its military capabilities. There is also the possibility of China formally giving military aid.
- For many months Russia has fired 60,000 shells every single day in a relentless barrage.
- Ukraine is out of weapons, hence its constant demands on the West for re-supply of everything and money.
- The fact is that the West is running out of armaments. The collapse in supply chains, and especially electronic chips and rare earth minerals, means that replacing lost weaponry is going to take months or years. Europe is running dry. Britain is so low on equipment and men that a Pentagon report stated that if Britain had to enter a war it could only last two days. America is also running out of munitions and is only offering Ukraine out of date stuff. The paucity of equipment being sent now (a few tanks, a few missile systems etc.) will achieve nothing but will be blown up within hours of placement.

Lie: Ukraine's victory will be secured by Western aid

This is just laughable. I have already explained that the West is running dry and is putting itself at risk. There is also evidence of war fatigue. EU nations are beginning to lose interest (despite EU Commission sabre-rattling) and at least half of the US electorate are now opposed to further involvement.

The current promises of hardware will not arrive in time to do any good and most will not arrive for many months. The recent arrival of four Polish Leopard 2 tanks is nothing other than grandstanding.

The planned move of 14 British Challenger 2 tanks, 32 AS-90 artillery pieces and several hundred other vehicles is worrying. This gives away many of the few vehicles that the British Army has. This will denude the British battle-group in Estonia of most of its combat power. But it will also compromise the secrecy of the Dorchester-armour: Challenger 2 which will be a number one target for Russia to capture and analyse.

However, there are surveillance images of a build up of military vehicles and tanks in the Baltic States. This appears to be readying for WWIII; which is very worrying. Strangely, these are all painted in desert-brown instead of wood-green camouflage.

Lie: Ukraine is holding Russia back and making territorial gains

- This is to misunderstand Russian military tactics, which are to minimise its own troop losses and move slowly.
- Remember that the goals are de-militarisation etc. not to take all of Ukraine over.
- Thus Russia will advance towards a city, attack it and then pull back leaving Ukraine forces to establish trenches and positions. Ukraine then claims a massive victory; but it is Pyrrhic.¹² These positions are then smashed with missile and artillery attacks to demilitarise. There are reports of two regiments being killed in a single day.
- Without any doubt Ukraine is not only losing this conflict, it is already completely lost. It cannot succeed. This is the view of all sound military commentators, such as Scott Ritter (ex-marine major and UN advisor) and Col Douglas MacGregor.
- The rhetoric of British politicians like Ben Wallace, Liz Truss, Boris Johnson and military spokesmen that claim Ukraine is winning, are simply a joke. These people are in fantasyland.

Lie: Zelensky is an admiral statesman

Truth: He is a thoroughly corrupt, cocaine-addicted, rich, evil man who is a mere puppet of the West. He is playing a role for media purposes. He is hated by the troops, as social media videos demonstrate. Indeed many have pledged to kill him if they survive. He has only survived assassination because of the tight Nazi security details protecting him (though even the Nazis threatened to kill him if he did not comply with their plans).

- Volodymyr Zelensky is the sixth and current president of Ukraine.
- He was formerly an actor and comedian with no experience in politics. He is currently playing a role in a script written by Elite powers.
- He achieved fame for playing a piano with his penis onstage in front of a live audience playing a fictional president.
- He gained power as a result of George Soros funding a huge promotional campaign for him on an anti-corruption ticket (yes really). He also claimed to seek peace with Russia.
- He has proved to be a barefaced liar.

- Under his leadership the country has become more and more corrupt (it was already corrupt). He crashed the economy. Crime proliferated. Ukraine became the centre of human trafficking, worth billions. The Mafia dominates.
- People are paying half of their salaries to heat the house. Living conditions are extremely difficult. Wages are low. Corruption is everywhere. Ordinary people are badly affected by crime.
- He is surrounded by real Nazis that form a government paramilitary unit, which is funded and supplied by NATO and the US.
- Zelensky has a millionaire's mansion on Miami Beach (how is that possible?). With other government executives he is pocketing money sent from the West, with no accountability, for aid.
- Ukraine has one of the most corrupt and evil governments in the world. Before the Russian conflict even the BBC exposed the Ukrainian Nazi problem and the inherent corruption. Now it is silent.

Lie: Putin is a warmonger

Despite a massive military success in the early days of the conflict Putin offered peace terms to Zelensky. The military operation was put on hold on Friday 25 February but Zelensky refused. The war could have ended then and the continuance is the fault of Zelensky. Putin offered peace talks after that in Turkey, but Boris Johnson and NATO pressurised Zelensky to refuse them.

It should be remembered that Putin is far more conciliatory than other Russian political leaders who are very hawkish. So far, Putin has been able to withstand them. The situation would be far worse if any of these hawks were in power.

Lie: Atrocities in the conflict are all conducted by the Russians

Truth

There is little real evidence of Russian atrocities but there is evidence of Russian clemency. However, there is overwhelming evidence of all sorts regarding Ukrainian atrocities. These atrocities go back to 2014 and still continue.

Ukrainian war crimes include: massacres of civilians, summary public executions, bombing civilian areas like market-places, public castration, eye gouging, rape, torture of women and men, burning alive, crushing under tanks, tying people naked to lamp posts in the cold, carving of flesh, and much more. There is video evidence for many of these things.

- There were reports, such as by French journalists, that the Ukrainian Nazis have been using missile strikes against their own population in order to create a propaganda offensive in the West. An administration building in Kharkiv was struck by a missile and publicised in the Mail. However, the missile came from the west and struck the south-western corner which could not have been fired from Russian positions at the time.
- The commander of an Azov detachment of the 13th Armoured Forces of the National Guard of Ukraine brought the civilian population into the area of the Azovstal Plant which was then extensively mined with military equipment placed in the courtyard. In the event of a breakthrough in the defence of the city the Nazis planned to blow up the

plant's building with the civilians inside. This was to blacken the name of the Russians and blame it on artillery fire.¹³

- Ukrainian Nazi groups have positioned military units with Grad rockets next to apartment blocks and used civilians as human shields.
- Nazis shot civilians trying to escape the cities. Videos have been uploaded of entire families shot dead in their cars as they tried to escape cities. Zelensky has ordered all people fleeing Ukraine to be shot on sight.
- In the basement of a school on Gastelo Street, over 60 civilians were forcibly detained with more than half being women and children. The Azov unit mined this building. This situation also occurred in Artyomovsk.
- The Mayor of Mariupol, Vadim Boychenko, published photos of the shelling of a residential area by the Russian military. However, this showed that the projectile was a Tochka-U, which is only in service with Ukrainian troops.
- The massacre at Bucha was conducted by the Ukrainian National Police and Nazis. The victims were Russian collaborators (signified by the white armbands). There was a video available showing a Ukrainian Nazi asking for permission to shoot such people; he was given that permission. There are multiple lies in the western narrative of this, as I have explained elsewhere. The Russians had withdrawn before this massacre took place and they had given provisions to the locals (note the green plastic boxes). This was a punishment massacre of Russian sympathisers who had received aid.
- There are multiple videos and photographs demonstrating Ukrainian torture and execution, especially of captured Russian soldiers, such as two soldiers castrated and naked then tormented before they were shot in the street.
- Deserters have been stripped naked and tied to lamp posts in the freezing cold.
- Elite sources have given funding to European lawyers to write reports and make claims of Russian atrocities that should form the basis of future war-crime trials. Much of this is sheer propaganda.
- POWs held by Russian troops have been treated well and even returned, such as the mercenary Aidan Aslin.
- Russian soldiers with reporter Patrick Lancaster found a dead woman in the rubble of a building. She had been raped, tortured and Nazi symbols carved into her flesh. Lancaster's video report showed her body.
- Though there are many Western claims of Russian atrocities, there is little or no actual evidence of such. However, there are masses of evidence (photos, videos, witness testimonies, satellite images showing missile trajectories etc.) of Ukrainian atrocities.
- In war both sides commit atrocities in the heat of the moment. The question is whether the governing body sanctions atrocities or forbids them. There is no doubt that Ukrainian authorities have condoned and encouraged atrocities. There is no evidence that Putin has done this; indeed there have been many examples of clemency to POWs; including bussing them home. Russia considers ordinary Ukrainians to be brothers.

Specific examples of media lies

• The media claimed that a group of 213 soldiers were trapped on Zmeiny Island ('Snake Island') on the Black Sea and supposedly stood bravely in defiance of the Russians and were killed. They were then honoured with a heroic award. In fact they surrendered and were taken prisoner and were returned to their families.

- The BBC and newspapers showed photo images of Russian warplanes flying in a V-formation over Kiev ready to attack. This footage was two-years old and was a flypast over Moscow.
- Footage was published of mobile incinerators with the claim that these were used by the Russians to get rid of human casualties. Then it was discovered that this was from 2013 YouTube footage of industrial incinerators getting rid of garbage.
- Stories ran that Putin had set fire to an ex-nuclear power plant and threatened a nuclear disaster. It turned out that a training building outside of the plant precincts had caught fire and there was no threat at all.
- The ghost of Kiev pilot: this story claimed that a sole Ukrainian pilot became a fighter ace in two days, downing several Russian warplanes. In fact this was a meme created by a comedian spoof director, Sam Hyde.
- Russian tanks running over civilians: the tanks turned out to be Ukrainian.
- Zelensky claimed that Russia had attacked the Babi Yar Holocaust memorial in Kiev in an attempt to '*erase our history*'. Then an Israeli journalist visited the site to find that it was entirely unscathed.

Western aircraft

Zelensky keeps demanding that the West supply F-16s and other warplanes; his own air force was virtually destroyed early on in the conflict. This is utterly ridiculous.

Firstly, this would be a significant act of aggression that could lead to formal war between Russia and NATO nations. The West knows that it is not ready for this and that it is incapable of sustaining a hot war on that level.

Secondly, the US has so far refused to send any warplanes but there is talk of Britain sending Typhoons. This is also ridiculous. Britain does not have enough of these for its own defence let alone giving some away. The Ukraine pilots would also need a great deal of training just to be able to fly them. They are not used to Western aircraft. After that they would need more training in battle tactics and sorties. But Typhoons are no match for Russian weaponry, missiles or dog-fights with Sukhoi SU-34s. They would be speedily destroyed and reveal the shortcomings of UK equipment. It would make more sense for EU nations to send MiG warplanes, but they appear to be loath to do this. Again that would cross a line of aggression and could spell a Russian hypersonic ICBM targeting their country.

Thirdly, it would make more sense to send a ground attack aircraft like the US A-10 Warthog. But the Americans want to hold on to these, as they are vital to their own military needs. The same problems would apply – training, maintenance etc. But even though the A-10 is very heavily defended against smaller arms attack, it is a 1960s-design aircraft that would not survive the more sophisticated modern Russian missile systems.

So all the media talk about sending warplanes is just hot air.

Lie: the whole story about Bakhmut

Lie: Ukraine is winning the battle of Bakhmut

For weeks the Western media promoted this siege as a Ukrainian example of overcoming Russian aggression. It proclaimed that resilient Ukrainian troops had driven Russia back.

In fact, this was an example of Russia protecting its own troops from unnecessary risk in urban fighting so that it could destroy Ukrainian troops, constantly sent into the battle lines in the city, by artillery and missile strikes. There are reports of thousands of Ukrainian soldiers being destroyed in a single day. Tens of thousands have been killed in this pointless defensive action.

The defeat of the city was virtually admitted when Zelensky fired his general in command.

Lie: Bakhmut is not important anyway

When it became too obvious that Ukraine was not winning this protracted battle, the media then said that Bakhmut was not a strategically important city anyway. This is false. Bakhmut is a very important military target for Russia. It breaks the line of Ukrainian defences and opens the way into the Ukrainian heartland. Bakhmut is central in the military communication lines. Around Bakhmut there are also hills which provide excellent military bases to attack distant areas by artillery and missiles. After taking Bakhmut (which will happen very soon) the way is open to conquer Ukraine's third biggest city. Even Zelensky recently said that Bakhmut was '*tactical*' - by which he meant '*strategic*'.

Bakhmut is encircled

Russia has currently almost completely encircled Bakhmut and is pummelling the city, which contains entrenched Ukrainian military positions, with constant shell-fire. The city is being demolished. Zelensky, in his usual fashion, continues to send inexperienced, untrained troops into this hellstorm to be killed within hours. A fifth of Ukrainian soldiers are deserting, even though Zelensky has ordered immediate execution for desertion; the troops understand that this action is suicide.

Military commanders have pleaded with Zelensky to withdraw all the soldiers from Bakhmut left in a hopeless position. There are about 7,000 soldiers in the city centre and more in the surrounding areas; perhaps 20,000 in all. There is currently only a narrow escape avenue, which is fast closing. Instead he commanded them to remain but he did withdraw the elite forces, leaving the conscripts to die.

The whole presentation by the media is false.

What happens next?

Bakhmut is lost, pure and simple. This secures Russian control of all of the Donbass. The way is then open to occupy deep into Ukraine heartland. The question is, what happens next?

Option One

If the West had any sense, it would urge Ukraine to negotiate peace terms. It will lose the Donbass and must accept the loss of Crimea. This will prevent any more needless loss of life and avert World War Three. No doubt Russia will also demand that Ukraine never be a part of NATO or the EU.

Option Two

The plans of the Elite mean that the West will not accept Option One.

It is much more likely that the West will push Zelensky to ramp up the conflict and provide more weapons. This could push the West from a proxy war into a blatant war, triggering WWIII. While knowing the true state of Bakhmut, Joe Biden, Jens Stoltenberg and Rishi Sunak have promised more resources and training with fighter jets being promised for the future. As the West gets desperate, there could be the release of weapons of mass destruction. These would include: nuclear devices, chemical weapon attacks or biological weapon attacks. Although Russia destroyed many bio-labs, there are still stores of bioweapons and chemical weapons in Ukraine overseen by the US military. Tactical nuclear devices could be delivered fairly quickly. The problem is that a tactical nuclear strike would quickly escalate into full nuclear war – then Armageddon. The Pentagon understands this and is constantly warning US Neocon hawk politicians to pull back from these options. Even Kissinger has urged for peace talks.

If doomsday weapons are discounted, then the West will ramp up the stakes in whatever way it can, but this will inevitably mean sending in NATO personnel. The Ukraine army is decimated and further conflict would require Western troops on the ground (they are already present but in secret and in small numbers). Sending fighter-bomber aircraft would necessitate NATO pilots because training Ukraine pilots would take months. Experienced fitters and engineers would also have to be imported for maintenance. This will mean real war between Russia and the West. It is also possible that Poland could be urged to open up a second front, it already has 200,000 military personnel on the Belarus border. But this is insane.

Russia will then have no option but to defeat all of Ukraine. It does not want to do this and considers ordinary Ukrainians as brothers. But war with the west will mean that Russia has to obliterate the whole of Ukraine to secure its border from ever-expanding NATO aggression. This will mean a long, protracted war, which will drain the West of military resources, ruin its economies and could involve China and Belarus siding militarily with Russia. However, the military industrial complex will make trillions of profits.

A watershed moment

The taking of Bakhmut means the end of this stage of the 'war'. It will be a decisive moment. There is the opportunity to stop this madness at that point. Yet the likelihood is that the insane, psychopathic West will seek to escalate the conflict and risk global war.

Lie: the world is against Putin

Firstly, the Russian population is still in full support of Putin and the conflict. In fact, reporters have recently said that civilian support has increased. There is very little dissent in Russia.

Russian people have a far better grasp of what is really going on than the sheep in the West dominated by the lying BBC. I am constantly astonished at the opinions of gullible British people who think they know what is happening but have not a clue about the reality.

Secondly, Russia's natural economic allies, the BRICS nations, have always been in support.¹⁴ Sometimes this is stated formally and openly, at other times it is tacit for political reasons.

Thirdly, in the recent UN vote on the issue¹⁵ about 40 nations clearly sided with Russia by either opposing the motion put forward or abstaining. The nations on Russia's side are the most populous in the world (China, India, etc.) which means that, by population numbers, most of the world supports Putin. 141 countries backed the resolution for Russia to

withdraw but 32 nations abstained (inc. China, Armenia, Bangladesh, Bolivia, Cuba, El Salvador, Ethiopia, India, Kazakhstan, Iran, various African states, Pakistan, Tajikistan, Sudan, Sri Lanka, South Africa, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, Guinea, Vietnam, Zimbabwe) and seven voted against (Eritrea, Korea, Mali, Nicaragua, Russia, Syria, Belarus).

Lie: Putin is causing inflation

Salmon is up 46%. How is that caused by Putin? Eggs and chicken are up at varying amounts; often double the previous price. But these are caused by the US killing flocks of birds due to one chicken testing positive for Covid or being merely suspected as having Avian Flu.

The government is keen to blame everything on Putin as part of a fearmongering campaign to delude the public and keep it on side in attacking Russia as the big bogeyman.

The chief cause of inflation is the government printing far too much currency, failed lockdown policies, furlough schemes and not growing the GDP. Blaming Putin is a distraction from blaming the government – the true culprit. High energy prices are entirely down to the West's sanctions on cheap Russian gas.

Lie: Putin is causing food shortages

The temporary halting of grain from Ukraine (the third biggest exporter) was due to Ukraine mining the sea off the coast and sinking ships to hinder a potential Russian sea invasion. It was Russia that cleared these and enabled grain to be exported.

The cause of shortages affecting food is the incredibly stupid Russian sanctions imposed by the West. All this has done is devastate Europe while the Russian currency has strengthened and exports switched to other favourable countries. The sanctions have led to a massive rise in energy prices; shortages and price increases of fertilisers and shortages of other products (e.g. timber). These aggregate into massive cost increases for farmers and thence shortages and cost increases because many farmers are simply stopping grain production or quitting farming.

On top of this are the stupid policies of governments attacking farming in the name of climate change insanity. Britain is paying farmers to quit or to stop agriculture in order to rewild the land. But Britons cannot live off trees and beavers.

The Netherlands is in the process of eliminating 90% of its farms, the most productive in the world. This is leading to a lack of fruit and vegetables in the supply chain. There are other causes of collapse in the food supply chain, especially in America. This includes the deliberate burning down of food processing plants.

Non of these problems are caused by Putin; yet the West continually blames him.

The current state of Ukraine and the prognosis

Ukraine is finished; it is already a failed state. I warned that this would happen in 2014, that the Ukrainian people were in a potential wretched state and that the nation would be devastated.¹⁶

There is a massive 'brain-drain' of the top intellectual people. Eight million people have fled the country westwards. Two million have fled eastwards to Russia. These people have stated that they will never go back to Ukraine. The original population of about 37 million people has dropped to about 18 million.

40% of the cities are destroyed. The longer the conflict continues, more will be destroyed.

Russia controls the industrial base of the nation, which it will not relinquish.

The economy is already shattered; yet it is deeply in debt to Western banks. This debt can never be paid thus the banks will take infrastructure in payment (bridges, roads, ports etc.).

Yet the West wants the war to continue to drain Russia; this means to the last dead Ukrainian. Zelensky the puppet actor and the West seek to continue despite the appalling lost situation. Being out of troops and conscripting old men, young boys, girls and prisoners, Zelensky gave a speech telling the US that it will have to send its 'sons and daughters' to fight for Ukraine and die. There is no allowance for any peace negotiations.

NATO (Stoltenberg) has stated that Ukraine will join both the EU and NATO. This means that Russia has no choice. With a hostile, well-sourced nation on its direct border, it will now have to push onwards and capture or destroy all of Ukraine to create a buffer zone. This will mean surrounding Kiev and threatening to destroy it completely, forcing Ukraine to capitulate. This was not Russia's choice.

Note

Russia is now the centre of world Christianity

Albeit in a Russian Orthodox format.¹⁷ It is building new churches every week. Christianity is now virtually dead on its feet in the West, killed by the slow degradation of Elite sponsored corruption, perversion and stealth attacks. Only a few churches hold on to traditional orthodoxy. Many Western historic church buildings are now bars, night-clubs, restaurants and residences.

The leader of Russia is a declared, baptised [Russian Orthodox] Christian believer. His policies reflect traditional Christian values. The leader of Britain is a Hindu. Previous leaders were secular atheists in reality, even if they had a church background (e.g. Theresa May). The Mayor of London is a Muslim. King Charles will deny his traditional oath as defender of Christianity to swear to be the defender of all faiths (polytheism). When a Christian stood for the leadership of the SNP in Scotland, there was a national outcry against her. Many Western leaders are secretly Luciferians and Freemasons. There are far more Communist leaders / lackeys in the Western establishment than there are Communists in Russia.

Russia is one of the foremost countries taking a stand against Elite strategies

It is standing off against the Petro-dollar. It is defying the central banks. It is withstanding Western sanctions and draining the West. Its economy is backed by gold. It is legalising against Woke ideology. It is fighting against sexual perversion agendas. It is safeguarding

the sanctity of children. It safeguards a Christian education. It teaches a true evaluation of history. Its health system is still secure. Energy is cheap. Food is plentiful. The elderly are valued.

Russia has a traditional secure economy

Not only is its currency backed by gold and silver, it is based upon sound policies centred on a historical understanding of true economics. Putin learned the lessons of Western fake economics and fiat currency in the period after Yeltsin when the Western / Jewish oligarchs raped the Russian economy. Putin turned from the West to strip economics back and start again on a sound premise. Putin, with allies, formed the BRICS economic partnership, which other nations are now clamouring to join, including Saudi Arabia. He formed new trade partnerships. The military industrial complex costs less than a tenth of America's but produces far better products.

Russia is based upon traditional family values and the principles of natural moral law

Russia began as a Christian nation in the days of the Kievan Rus under Vladimir the First after his conversion to Christ and abandoning Viking paganism.¹⁸ Its social history developed on the basis of traditional Christian values. The moral law was entwined in the social order. Thus children were protected and loved. The old were treated with respect. Truth was valued but lies were despised. Hard work was encouraged. A peaceful social order was desired. Farming was valued. Families were sacrosanct. Outside of the autocratic government, local villages had a decentralised, accountable leadership where the counsel of elders was respected. Monks / elders (*starets*) and priests were honoured.

All this changed in the Bolshevik Revolution, which destroyed the Christian testimony and devastated traditional social values. This was the deliberate policy of the mainly Jewish Socialist leadership. It was 70 years of testing for the Russian people under terrible hardships, torture, murder, and massacres. Tens of millions died. Christianity went underground. After the rise of Putin this all changed. He oversaw the return of the Christian testimony and the rebuilding of burned churches and the restoration of the clergy. The land returned to the values of Vladimir I. This is why the Russian people love Putin.

Conclusion

The defaming of Russia is a key part of the ingredients in the Elite arsenal to change the world and bring about fascist control over everyone. Before they control the globe, Russia has to be smashed and then fragmented into smaller states dominated by the West. The massive population of Russian Orthodox Christians praying against evil is also a big problem to overcome.

This is why the Russian meddling in American elections fairy story was pursued for years despite not a shred of evidence for it, as was eventually formally stated; but the propaganda continued. There was also the charade about the alleged Russian Skripal poisoning nonsense in Salisbury. Now the anti-Russian narrative has shifted to a claimed illegal invasion of Ukraine forming the preparation for war against Europe. This is a scaremongering tactic to spread fear amongst gullible people.

The West does not want peace. Russia tried to broker peace within weeks of the conflict to liberate the Russian Donbass but the West rejected this. Instead NATO began a massive build up of military aid and billions of dollars to prop up the Ukraine whose defeat was already certain. The West knows that Ukraine is defeated but it doesn't care. Its purpose is to bleed Russia of military and economic resources and hope to make ordinary Russians opposed to Putin and destabilise society. It will try to weaken Russia to the point of killing every available Ukrainian soldier. NATO cares nothing about Ukrainians; it is concerned only with the strategic territory.

There has been talk of using nuclear weapons when Ukraine runs out of troops and munitions but this will be Armageddon. Russia has insisted that it will not strike first but will retaliate against any nuclear strike, limited or otherwise. This policy is insane. Russia has the capability to shoot down any Western nuclear missile with its far superior missile defence systems (S-500 and upward) so no (or at least few) Western missiles will reach their target, but the radioactive fallout will be inevitable. Western defence systems, such as the US Patriot, are very poor in comparison so that they will not be able to shoot down any Russian ICBMs, especially not a hypersonic missile. Russia could survive a nuclear exchange but America and Europe could not. If the US starts nuclear war, the result will be a world dominated by Russia, China and India. The US and Europe may no longer exist, except as a radiated wasteland.

The basis of this geo-political rivalry is also tacitly spiritual. Russia and Putin are steeped in Christianity and Biblical principles, at least in a professed manner. Putin is a baptised, devout Russian Orthodox believer, as is the majority of the nation. He is far more balanced and measured than other atheistic political leaders who would have pursued a much more aggressive conflict. On the other hand, the West is dominated by psychopathic Satanists and Luciferians who are devoted to satanic principles expressed in their Freemasonry, Kabbalism, Sabbateanism, Gnosticism, Theosophy and Talmudism.

Christian observers of all this need to be very careful. So many have been utterly fooled into accepting the Western narrative because that is what they are used to, especially the BBC which is now the fount of lies. While not supporting any human government, Christians certainly need to avoid a satanic narrative. Christians supporting the Western narrative about Ukraine will damage their spiritual lives through their lack of discernment. Furthermore, promoting hatred of Russians, many of whom are genuine Christians, will require serious repentance or face God's chastisement.

I am appalled to find so many supposed Christian believers fully accepting the Western lying narrative, denigrating Russians seeking to liberate their own people from extermination and supporting Satanists and a satanic agenda. Their deception will lead to a damaged personal state.

As was the case with the Syrian conflict, which was the precursor for many issues now occurring in Ukraine, the Western narrative is packed full of lies from start to finish. We even have the White Helmets operating in Ukraine as well as ISIS. Both were created and financed by the West. [The White Helmets are a British secret services psy-op initiated by James Le Mesurier to funnel money to Islamic terrorist groups and produce propaganda videos and false flag operations (e.g. Douma).] The parallels are sharp. Syria and Russia are subject to massive Western sanctions. They are both the victims of huge amounts of false propaganda. Assad and Putin are both very popular leaders but are both vilified as demons by the West. The West channelled huge funding and resources to terrorists to overcome their elected regimes. The White Helmets operate in both places. ISIS operates in both places. The US has illegal military bases in Syria and Ukraine. The West uses Israeli

resources and personnel in both places. The national populations have suffered as a result of Western inference (e.g. power cuts, lack of food, lack of water etc.). We could go on.

The Western actions in this conflict are not only illegal and unethical, they are anti-God. Russia may or may not be a comparatively more righteous nation but its actions here have been motivated by good – to rescue the 4 million Donbass Russians from extinction (which was being supported and encouraged by the West using your taxes). You need to permanently turn off the BBC and other mainstream media channels and start discerning what is going on.
