The Institutions Have Fallen

An essay

The subversion of the institutions by radical Socialists

In 1921 Communists, like Antonio Gramsci, began opining that Western society had to be subverted from within in order to bring about a thorough Marxist revolution and change society. In the 1930s strategies to achieve this were being developed by sociologists and philosophers in the Frankfurt School but the Fabian Society, an organisation of Socialists aiming at the gradual rather than revolutionary achievement of socialism, had been considering this matter decades before.

The plan was nicknamed as a 'long march through the institutions'. These Marxists realised that it was only by destroying the Christian basis of Western society, and thoroughly decimating the ideological planks of Western culture that a successful Marxist coup could take place.

Thus began the process that, 100 years later, has resulted in the complete subversion of Western cultural institutions. Through strategies like Post-Modernism, Political Correctness, Wokeness and the schismatic factionalising of society coupled with multiculturalism, mass immigration and the corruption of politics and justice, the Marxists have ruined life in Great Britain and English-speaking nations.

Other organisations, such as Common Purpose, which programmed and placed chosen corrupted leaders in all levels of society, only hastened the collapse of reason, honour, righteousness, truth and justice. For example the utterly corrupt commissioner of the Metropolitan Police, Cressida Dick, has destroyed the integrity, honour and efficiency of London's police force. She is willing to blatantly lie in TV interviews to hide the deliberate totalitarian and perverse actions of the police in following illegal strategies – just as a trained Common Purpose graduate is conditioned to do.

All the key institutions of British society have now fallen prey to the Cultural Marxist agenda. It is too late to preserve them as they are; they must be uprooted and restarted if there is to be any hope. For example, to rescue education you would have to sack all the teacher training college tutors and reemploy only those with no prior political agenda but with a commitment to logic, reason and critical thinking.

Shire Britons haven't fallen

Although the institutions have fallen, the British people have not. The vast majority of Britons (Left and Right wing) still retain a love of the former principles on which Great Britain stood: honour, decency, basic Christian principles, justice, genuine toleration, patriotism, humility, self-control, and hard work. Most Britons, outside of the metropolitan university bubbles, still retain plain common sense and rationality and feel bemused by what has happened around them; nay, many of them feel helpless and without a voice.

The subversives control the narrative

The problem is that all the institutions that do have a voice are corrupt, venal and pathetic; but they control the narrative because they have the social power. Whether it is the education systems from top to bottom, the judiciary, law and order, the media, the

entertainment industry and even most religious organisations - all of them have been captured and dance to the tune of progressive Socialist masters.

Sometimes this power is openly evident, such as in the official toppling of statues of historic figures for imagined crimes against modern thinking; no matter how much good the character did in his/her lifetime for which he/she was hailed as a hero worth remembering. But often the full effect of the programming is not understood; such as the appalling conditioning that is now going on in the school and university systems. Children as young as four are being propagandised; even to the effect of being led into changing their sexual status and facilitating drastic changes to their lifestyle – only for them to collapse into mental health crises in later life.

I was going to go on to itemise how all the institutions have fallen; but I have really dealt with this in several previous papers and cannot really add any more. I will leave this as a concise essay lamenting how serious a situation Britain now finds itself in.

The need to wake up

People must wake up to understand the depth of the cultural destruction that has already occurred. For the sake of their children, they must begin to consider this matter and take it seriously.

You cannot trust in politicians any more. Parliament is now an utter failure, if not a complete disgrace. The Covid totalitarianism alone proves this. Democracy is not going to save you; it is ruined. The political party system ensures that only corrupt people gain positions of power, with few exceptions. But then there are the elite puppet masters above national government who really call the tune: global corporatists, bankers, financiers etc.

Yet throughout history massive changes have occurred as a result of simple grass roots movements gathering pace and effecting social revolution. It begins with small gatherings of like-minded people fellowshipping together to discuss the truth on various issues and seeking to do what good they can. In the past such social developments eventually brought down despotic kings.

Huge demonstrations in the streets, while offering encouragement to the sane majority, will never do any real change on their own. A million people marching through London didn't stop Tony Blair taking Britain into an illegal and wicked war against Iraq that cost over a million innocent lives and destabilised the Levant. More lasting is local social change at a grass root level.

But before this, people must wake up. It is essential that the silent majority start to realise that the situation we find ourselves in was planned a long time ago and brought upon us by corrupt people put into positions of high office. All the divisions in society are not accidental; they are deliberate, well financed strategies to create schism, hate and civil unrest. People in power are deliberately setting marginalised factions against one another to destabilise society and sow the seeds of discontent. Their hope is for civil war to erupt and enable a Marxist revolution.

Grass roots reconstruction

The only way to stop this is to understand what is going on and initiate local strategies that bring people together and establish communities where love and common sense reign.

Some simple ideas:

• Where the elite have brought ugliness to a town to create depression, start planting flowers, herbs, shrubs and trees in every available space.

- Try to develop communal allotments for growing food for the community. Convert brownfield sites into gardens. Plant apple trees for free nutrition.
- Set up local farmer's markets to bring good produce to an area and divert traffic away from corporate supermarkets.
- Set up a Christmas market.
- Set up groups to remove debris and garbage in public spaces.
- If there is no artistic expression in a town, establish: folk clubs, other music genre clubs, art clubs, drama societies, dance clubs, teaching clubs etc. Ugly, austere, socially bereft Basildon was greatly assisted by individuals who set up music venues for kids.
- Establish educational clubs for children: stamp collecting, coin collecting, bird watching, Scouts/Guides, Cubs/Brownies, Red Cross, Boys Brigade, etc.
- Set up self-help groups, voluntary counselling centres, assistance for the elderly.
- Take-over Post Offices about to close.
- Stop pubs from closing.
- Pressurise councils to provide bus services.
- Boycott organisations that are detrimental to community.
- Set up a local kid's sports centre. Develop a local junior football/cricket team.
- Establish night schools.

If I can think of these things in five minutes, you can think of many more in your area.

Every time the government or council tries to ruin the community by closing down this or that service, get volunteers to replace it.

The objective is to make your local area a haven of community, honour, respect, goodness, charity and social excitement. If thousands of local communities began to do this, the whole country would be changed. Good people gravitate to good areas. With enough good people, you can eventually get decent folk into positions of local power and make radical changes.

The world as we know it is collapsing and we cannot change the world, but we don't have to sit back and do nothing for our fellow man. We can make positive contributions and do good within our own community.

The Cultural Marxist agenda is based on opposing every Christian principle, destroying the family, programming education and developing totalitarian control. It revels in creating ugliness, despair, dishonour, schism, lies, fraud, and blasphemy. You cannot change the institutions, but you can ignore them and create your own places of local creativity, love, peace, honour and respect.

For Christians

Although Christians are focused on the world to come, we still have a responsibility to do good to our fellow man and work for what is righteous in our local community. Sitting back and ignoring what is going on is being unfaithful; God expects us to be people that act well.

To start with, churches must never close again. Go to jail if need be but refuse to shut down church meetings by government diktat. Better still, start to meet as an underground church and ignore the trappings of formal institutions. Meet secretly in homes and take no money from the world.

Strive to be a source of truth. The world is dominated by lies, fraud and deceit. Understand what is going on and bring a divine perspective of truth to all that is around you. Be a local source of genuine knowledge and wisdom.

Do as much good to your fellow man as possible. To those who are called, set up charitable works, such as food centres for the poor or providing meals to the frail and elderly. Visit the sick and needy. Be a friend to the lonely. Support widows and orphans.

Whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold *water* in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall by no means lose his reward. Matt 10:42

Conclusion

We do not know the future. We cannot tell if this is the beginning of the end or just a step on the way. What is certain is that we are measured by how we respond to what is certainly an evil time. Do we give in and comply or do we refuse to submit to evil and insist on doing God's will; whatever the personal cost?
